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HB5	Leger	TAX CREDITS	Increases the amount of the earned income tax credit (Item #26) - Read by title, returned to the calendar.
HB14	Leger	TAX/TOBACCO TAX	Levies an additional tax on cigarettes (Item #4) - Sent to the Governor for executive approval.
HB18	Montoucet	TAX/TOBACCO TAX	Reduces the amount of the discount for accurately reporting and remitting excise taxes on certain tobacco products and the amount of the discount for stamping cigarettes (Item #22) - Sent to the Governor for executive approval.
HB20	Broadwater	TAX/CORP INCOME	Provides relative to the net operating loss deduction for corporate income tax (Item #5) - Scheduled for floor debate on 03/08/2016.
HB24	Jackson	TAX CREDITS	Repeals the three-year sunset of certain reductions to income and corporation franchise tax credits (Item #10) - Rules suspended, called out of its regular order. - Read third time by title, roll called on final passage, yeas 54, nays 47. Finally passed, title adopted, ordered to the Senate.
HB28	Cox	TAX/ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGE	Reduces the amount of the discount for accurately reporting and remitting excise taxes on alcoholic beverages and beer (Item #23) - Scheduled for floor debate on 03/08/2016.
HB29	Leger	TAX/CORP INCOME	Establishes a flat rate for purposes of calculating corporation income tax liability (Item #3) - Enrolled and signed by the Speaker of the House. - Sent to the Governor for executive approval.
HB30	Leger	TAX/SALES & USE	Provides for the collection of sales and use taxes due on sales made in Louisiana by a remote dealer (Item #30) - Sent to the Governor for executive approval.
HB31	Leger	TAX/INCOME TAX	(Constitutional Amendment) Eliminates the income tax deduction for federal income taxes paid for purposes of calculating corporate income tax liability (Items #2 and 17) - Enrolled and signed by the Speaker of the House. - Sent to the Governor for executive approval.
HB32	Leger	TAX/INCOME TAX	Reduces the rates for purposes of calculating the tax on the taxable income of individuals (Items #3 and 19) - Read by title, returned to the calendar.
HB33	Leger	TAX/INCOME TAX	Reduces the amount of the individual income tax deduction for excess federal itemized personal

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HB75	Stokes	TAX/INCOME TAX	Changes the rates and brackets for purposes of calculating individual income tax liability and eliminates certain deductions (Item #3) <ul style="list-style-type: none">- Rules suspended, called out of its regular order.- Read third time by title, amended, roll called on final passage, yeas 91, nays 11. Finally passed, title adopted, ordered to the Senate.
HB76	Stokes	TAX/INCOME TAX	(Constitutional Amendment) Eliminates the income tax deduction for federal income taxes paid for purposes of computing individual and corporate income taxes and references to the maximum amount of individual income tax rates and brackets (Item #3) <ul style="list-style-type: none">- Rules suspended, called out of its regular order.- Read third time by title, amended, roll called on final passage, yeas 91, nays 10. The bill, having received two-thirds vote of the elected members, was finally passed, title adopted, ordered to the Senate.
HB80	Stokes	TAX/INCOME TAX	Repeals the state income tax deduction for federal income taxes paid for purposes of calculating individual and corporate income taxes (Item #17) <ul style="list-style-type: none">- Rules suspended, called out of its regular order.- Read third time by title, amended, roll called on final passage, yeas 86, nays 14. Finally passed, title adopted, ordered to the Senate.
HB81	Thibaut	TAX/SALES & USE	(Constitutional Amendment) Repeals certain state sales and use tax exemptions (Items #16 and 36) <ul style="list-style-type: none">- Read by title, returned to the calendar.
HB84	Jackson	TAX/SALES-USE-EXEMPT	(Constitutional Amendment) Removes the prohibition against levying a state sales and use tax on the sale of gasoline (Item #36) <ul style="list-style-type: none">- Read by title, returned to the calendar.
HB87	Anders	TAX/INSURANCE PREMIUM	Reduces the amount of the insurance premium tax for certain Louisiana investments (Item #6) <ul style="list-style-type: none">- Received from the Senate with amendments.- Scheduled for floor debate on 03/08/2016.
HB101	Jackson	TAX/SALES-USE, STATE	Provides for the extent of applicability of various exclusions and exemptions from state sales and use tax (Item #36) <ul style="list-style-type: none">- Read by title, returned to the calendar.
HB104	Stokes	TAX/SALES-USE, STATE	Provides for the tax base for the state sales and use tax (Items #9 and 36) <ul style="list-style-type: none">- Read by title, returned to the calendar.
HB111	Marcelle	FUNDS/FUNDING	To eliminate the Debt Recovery Fund (Item #7) <ul style="list-style-type: none">- Scheduled for floor debate on 03/08/2016.
HB114	Thibaut	TAX/SALES-USE, STATE	Provides relative to the state sales and use tax (Item #30)

- HB121 Jackson TAX/SALES-USE, STATE
Provides relative to the imposition of state sales tax on certain motor fuels (Items #9 and 36)
- Read by title, returned to the calendar.
- HB125 Thibaut TAX/SALES & USE
Repeals the state sales and use tax exemption for food and prescription drugs (Item #36)
- Read by title, returned to the calendar.
- HCR4 Morris, Jay TAX/SALES-USE-EXEMPT
Suspends various exemptions as to the 2%, 1%, and 0.97% state sales and use tax levies (Item #36)

- HCR11 Schroder BUDGETARY CONTROLS
Creates the Task Force on Structural Change in Budget and Tax Policy to continue the budget and tax reform evaluations begun in the 2016 First Extraordinary Session and urges and requests the governor to support and implement initiatives for structural change introduced in upcoming sessions that will lead to savings through more efficient and effective state operations

- HCR12 Barras SPECIAL DAY/WEEK/MONTH
Recognizes March 7-13, 2016, as Multiple Sclerosis Awareness Week
- Read by title, rules suspended, adopted, ordered to the Senate.
- SB15 Morrell TAX/TAXATION
Provides relative to the application of refundable tax credits. (Item #26)(gov sig)
- Scheduled for floor debate on 03/08/2016.
- SB22 Morrell TAX EXEMPTIONS
Modifies the sales and use tax exemption for domed stadium facilities, baseball facilities, and other publicly owned facilities. (Item #36)(gov sig)
- Scheduled for floor debate on 03/08/2016.
- SCR6 Allain TAX/AD VALOREM
Establishes a task force to study ad valorem taxes that are offset by state tax credits.
- Scheduled for floor debate on 03/08/2016.
- SCR8 Morrell TAX/INCOME/CORPORATE
Clarifies the intent of the Legislature that Act 108 of the 2015 Regular Session is to apply prospectively only.
