- HB2 Broadwater TAX CREDITS
Repeals the Student Assessment for a Valuable Education (SAVE) credit program (Item #14)
- Received from the Senate with amendments.
 - Rules suspended.
 - Read by title, roll called, yeas 103, nays 0, Senate amendments concurred in.
 - Enrolled and signed by the Speaker of the House.
 - Sent to the Governor for executive approval.
- HB19 James TAX/CORP FRANCHISE
Provides relative to the entities to which corporate franchise tax applies (Item #28)
- Received from the Senate with amendments.
 - Rules suspended.
 - Read by title, roll called, yeas 74, nays 23. The Senate amendments, having received two-thirds vote of the elected members, were concurred in.
 - Enrolled and signed by the Speaker of the House.
- HB22 Jackson TAX/TAX REBATES
Repeals the three-year sunset of certain reductions to tax rebates (Item #11)
- Read by title, roll called, yeas 83, nays 8, Senate amendments rejected, conference committee appointment pending.
 - House conferees appointed: Jackson, Abramson, and Barras.
 - Conference Committee report received.
 - Conference Committee Report read, roll called, yeas 73, nays 27. The Conference Committee Report was adopted.
 - Notice of Senate adoption of Conference Committee Report.
- HB23 Jackson TAX/CORP INCOME
Repeals three-year sunset of certain reductions to corporate income tax deductions, exemptions, and exclusions (Item #12)
- Read by title, roll called, yeas 88, nays 5, Senate amendments rejected, conference committee appointment pending.
 - House conferees appointed: Jackson, Abramson, and Barras.
 - Conference Committee report received.
 - Conference Committee Report read, roll called, yeas 65, nays 36. The Conference Committee Report was adopted.
- HB24 Jackson TAX CREDITS
Repeals the three-year sunset of certain reductions to income and corporation franchise tax credits (Item #10)
- Received from the Senate with amendments.

 - Read by title, roll called, yeas 92, nays 1, Senate amendments rejected, conference committee appointment pending.
 - House conferees appointed: Jackson, Abramson, and Barras.

- HB27 Cox TAX/ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGE

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Increases the excise tax levied on certain alcoholic beverages (Item #20)

- Enrolled and signed by the Speaker of the House.
- Sent to the Governor for executive approval.

HB39 Stokes TAX/EXCISE

Levies an automobile rental tax (Item #25)

- Sent to the Governor for executive approval.

HB43 White, Malinda TAX/SALES & USE

Provides for the amount of vendors compensation authorized as compensation for the collection and remittance of state sales and use taxes (Item #21)

- Rules suspended, called out of its regular order.
- Read by title, roll called, yeas 89, nays 5, Senate amendments concurred in.
- Enrolled and signed by the Speaker of the House.
- Sent to the Governor for executive approval.

HB55 Leger TAX/INCOME TAX

Requires that certain deductible items be added-back on certain corporate income tax returns (Item #5)

- Received from the Senate with amendments.
- Rules suspended.
- Read by title, roll called, yeas 92, nays 7, Senate amendments rejected, conference committee appointment pending.
- House conferees appointed: Leger, Abramson, and Stokes.
- Conference Committee report received.
- Conference Committee Report read, roll called, yeas 79, nays 17. The Conference Committee Report was adopted.
- Notice of Senate adoption of Conference Committee Report.

HB57 Stokes TAX CREDITS

Repeals three-year sunset on certain eligibility requirements relative to the income tax credit for net taxes paid to other states (Item #13)

HB59 Moreno TAX/SALES-USE, STATE

Provides relative to imposition of the state sales and use tax on hotels (Items #9 and 30)

HB61 Morris, Jay TAX/SALES & USE

To provide with respect to the applicability of certain exclusions and exemptions from state sales and use taxes

- Read by title, roll called, yeas 94, nays 5. The Senate amendments, not having received two-thirds vote of the elected members, were rejected. Conference committee appointment pending.

HB62 Jackson TAX/SALES-USE, STATE
Impose a one cent sales and use tax (Item #9)
