- SB1 Martiny FUNDS/FUNDING
Provides relative to the definition of qualified event or qualified major event and site selection organizations for purposes of the Major Events Incentive Program. (gov sig)
- Senate floor amendments read and adopted. Read by title and passed by a vote of 38 yeas and 0 nays; ordered reengrossed and sent to the House. Motion to reconsider tabled.
- SB4 LaFleur FUNDS/FUNDING
Provides for the deposit and use of certain receipts of the Deepwater Horizon Economic Damages Settlement. (gov sig)
- Senate floor amendments read and adopted. Read by title and passed by a vote of 38 yeas and 0 nays; ordered reengrossed and sent to the House. Motion to reconsider tabled.
- SB12 Allain TAX/TAXATION
Changes certain refundable tax credits to nonrefundable tax credits. (See Act)
- Introduced in the Senate; read by title. Rules suspended. Read second time and referred to the Committee on Revenue and Fiscal Affairs.
- SB13 Allain TAX/AD VALOREM
Provides for carry forward rather than a refund of tax credits from ad valorem taxes paid to local governments. (gov sig)
- Introduced in the Senate; read by title. Rules suspended. Read second time and referred to the Committee on Revenue and Fiscal Affairs.
- SB14 Allain TAX/AD VALOREM
Constitutional amendment to add certain property tax exemptions and dedicate certain revenue. (Item #31)(2/3 - CA13s1(A))
- Introduced in the Senate; read by title. Rules suspended. Read second time and referred to the Committee on Revenue and Fiscal Affairs.
- SCR2 Morrell FUNDS/FUNDING
Provides relative to the Budget Stabilization Fund. (2/3 - CA7s10.3(C)(2))
- Read by title and adopted by a vote of 38 yeas and 0 nays. Ordered sent to the House.
- SCR3 Gatti COMMENDATIONS
Commends and recognizes the Steve Hoyle Intensive Substance Abuse Program.
- Read by title and adopted by a vote of 37 yeas and 0 nays. Ordered sent to the House.
- SR5 Brown, Troy COMMENDATIONS
Commends Virgil Dennis Joffrion upon the celebration of his ninetieth birthday.
- Introduced in the Senate. Read by title and placed on the Calendar for a second reading.
