- SCR4 Claitor CONGRESS
Memorializes Congress to extend Louisiana's seaward boundary in the Gulf of Mexico to three marine leagues.
- Enrolled. Signed by the President of the Senate.
- SCR6 Allain TAX/AD VALOREM
Establishes a task force to study ad valorem taxes that are offset by state tax credits.
- Introduced in the Senate. Read by title and placed on the Calendar for a second reading.
- SCR7 Chabert CONGRESS
Memorializes Congress to maintain the Outer Continental Shelf revenue sharing arrangement passed under the Gulf of Mexico Energy Security Act of 2006.
- Introduced in the Senate. Read by title and placed on the Calendar for a second reading.
- SR10 Colomb CONDOLENCES
To extend sincere condolences to the family of Maudry Prejean Batiste on the occasion of her passing.
- Introduced in the Senate. Read by title and placed on the Calendar for a second reading.
- HB7 Jackson TAX/CORP INCOME-EXEMPT
Provides relative to corporate income exclusions for dividend income from certain banking institutions (Item #15)
- Reported without Legislative Bureau amendments. Read by title and passed to third reading and final passage.
- HB20 Broadwater TAX/CORP INCOME
Provides relative to the net operating loss deduction for corporate income tax (Item #5)
- Reported favorably. Rules suspended. Read by title and referred to the Legislative Bureau.
- HB30 Leger TAX/SALES & USE
Provides for the collection of sales and use taxes due on sales made in Louisiana by a remote dealer (Item #30)
- Reported with Legislative Bureau amendments which were read and adopted. Read by title and passed to third reading and final passage.
- HB54 Broadwater TAX/SALES & USE
Requires the advance payment of sales tax (Item #35)
- Reported with amendments. Rules suspended. Committee amendments read and adopted. Read by title and referred to the Legislative Bureau.
- HB55 Leger TAX/INCOME TAX
Requires that certain deductible items be added-back on certain corporate income tax returns (Item #5)
- Reported favorably. Rules suspended. Read by title and referred to the Legislative Bureau.
- HB59 Moreno TAX/SALES-USE, STATE
Provides relative to imposition of the state sales and use tax on hotels (Items #9 and 30)
- Reported without Legislative Bureau amendments. Read by title and passed to third reading and final passage.
- HB62 Jackson TAX/SALES-USE, STATE
Impose a one cent sales and use tax (Item #9)
- Reported with amendments. Rules suspended. Committee amendments read and adopted.
