SCR5	Colomb	CONDOLENCES	Expresses condolences upon the death of State Representative Ronnie Edwards. - Received from the House without amendments.
SCR6	Allain	TAX/AD VALOREM	Establishes a task force to study ad valorem taxes that are offset by state tax credits. - Read second time by title and referred to the Committee on Revenue and Fiscal Affairs.
SCR7	Chabert	CONGRESS	Memorializes Congress to maintain the Outer Continental Shelf revenue sharing arrangement passed under the Gulf of Mexico Energy Security Act of 2006. - Read second time by title and referred to the Committee on Finance.
SCR8	Morrell	LEGISLATIVE AUDITOR	Clarifies the intent of the Legislature that Act 108 of the 2015 Regular Session is to apply prospectively only. - Rules suspended. Introduced in the Senate; read by title. Rules suspended. Read second time and referred to the Committee on Revenue and Fiscal Affairs.
SR10	Colomb	CONDOLENCES	To extend sincere condolences to the family of Maudry Prejean Batiste on the occasion of her passing. - Read by title and returned to the Calendar, subject to call.
SR11	Peterson	CONGRESS	Memorializes Congress to confirm a Supreme Court Justice to fill the late Justice Antonin Scalia's seat upon receiving a nomination from President Barack Obama. - Introduced in the Senate. Read by title and placed on the Calendar for a second reading.
HB20	Broadwater	TAX/CORP INCOME	Provides relative to the net operating loss deduction for corporate income tax (Item #5) - Reported without Legislative Bureau amendments. Read by title and passed to third reading and final passage.
HB29	Leger	TAX/CORP INCOME	Establishes a flat rate for purposes of calculating corporation income tax liability (Item #3) - Reported favorably. Rules suspended. Read by title and referred to the Legislative Bureau. - Reported without Legislative Bureau amendments. Read by title and passed to third reading and final passage.
HB31	Leger	TAX/INCOME TAX	(Constitutional Amendment) Eliminates the income tax deduction for federal income taxes paid for purposes of calculating corporate income tax liability (Items #2 and 17) - Reported favorably. Rules suspended. Read by title and referred to the Legislative Bureau. - Reported without Legislative Bureau amendments. Read by title and passed to third reading and final passage.
HB39	Stokes	TAX/EXCISE	Levies an automobile rental tax (Item #25) - Received in the Senate; read by title Rules suspended. Read second time by title and referred to the Committee on Revenue and Fiscal Affairs.
