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SB25	Cortez	FUNDS/FUNDING	Sunsets all sales and use tax exemptions other than those that are constitutionally protected. (Item #36)(7/1/17) - Rules suspended. Reported with amendments. Rules suspended. Read by title; Committee amendments read and adopted. Ordered engrossed and passed to third reading and final passage.
SCR7	Chabert	CONGRESS	Memorializes Congress to maintain the Outer Continental Shelf revenue sharing arrangement passed under the Gulf of Mexico Energy Security Act of 2006. - Enrolled. Signed by the President of the Senate.
SCR9	Walsworth	CONDOLENCES	Expresses condolences upon the death of James Donald "Don" Halsell. - Received from the House without amendments.
SCR10	Walsworth	CONDOLENCES	Expresses condolences upon the death of William "Bill" Smith Jr. - Received from the House without amendments.
HB2	Broadwater	TAX CREDITS	Repeals the Student Assessment for a Valuable Education (SAVE) credit program (Item #14) - Rules suspended. Reported with amendments. Rules suspended. Committee amendments read and adopted. Read by title and referred to the Legislative Bureau. - Reported without Legislative Bureau amendments. Read by title and passed to third reading and final passage.
HB7	Jackson	TAX/CORP INCOME-EXEMPT	Provides relative to corporate income exclusions for dividend income from certain banking institutions (Item #15) - Signed by the President of the Senate.
HB14	Leger	TAX/TOBACCO TAX	Levies an additional tax on cigarettes (Item #4) - Received in the Senate; read by title Rules suspended. Read second time by title and referred to the Committee on Revenue and Fiscal Affairs.
HB18	Montoucet	TAX/TOBACCO TAX	Reduces the amount of the discount for accurately reporting and remitting excise taxes on certain tobacco products and the amount of the discount for stamping cigarettes (Item #22) - Received in the Senate; read by title Rules suspended. Read second time by title and referred to the Committee on Revenue and Fiscal Affairs.
HB20	Broadwater	TAX/CORP INCOME	Provides relative to the net operating loss deduction for corporate income tax (Item #5) - Read by title and returned to the Calendar, subject to call.
HB29	Leger	TAX/CORP INCOME	Establishes a flat rate for purposes of calculating corporation income tax liability (Item #3) - Read by title and returned to the Calendar, subject to call.
HB31	Leger	TAX/INCOME TAX	(Constitutional Amendment) Eliminates the income tax deduction for federal income taxes paid for

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purposes of calculating corporate income tax liability (Items #2 and 17)

- Read by title and returned to the Calendar, subject to call.

HB39 Stokes TAX/EXCISE

Levies an automobile rental tax (Item #25)

- Senate floor amendments read and adopted. Read by title, passed by a vote of 33 yeas and 5 nays, and ordered returned to the House. Motion to reconsider tabled.

HB43 White, Malinda TAX/SALES & USE

Provides for the amount of vendors compensation authorized as compensation for the collection and remittance of state sales and use taxes (Item #21)

- Read by title and returned to the Calendar, subject to call.

HB54 Broadwater TAX/SALES & USE

Requires the advance payment of sales tax (Item #35)

- Read by title and returned to the Calendar, subject to call.

HB55 Leger TAX/INCOME TAX

Requires that certain deductible items be added-back on certain corporate income tax returns (Item #5)

- Read by title and returned to the Calendar, subject to call.

HB57 Stokes TAX CREDITS

Repeals three-year sunset on certain eligibility requirements relative to the income tax credit for net taxes paid to other states (Item #13)

- Senate floor amendments read and adopted. Read by title, passed by a vote of 31 yeas and 8 nays, and ordered returned to the House. Motion to reconsider tabled.

HB71 Barras TAX CREDITS

Reduces the amount of certain Enterprise Zone tax credits and removes certain hotels from eligibility (Item #27)

- Received in the Senate; read by title Rules suspended. Read second time by title and referred to the Committee on Revenue and Fiscal Affairs.

HB72 Shadoin TAX/SALES-USE, STATE

Increases the state sales tax on telecommunications services (Item #24)

- Senate floor amendments read and adopted. Read by title, passed by a vote of 35 yeas and 4 nays, and ordered returned to the House. Motion to reconsider tabled.

HB87 Anders TAX/INSURANCE PREMIUM

Reduces the amount of the insurance premium tax for certain Louisiana investments (Item #6)

- Rules suspended. Reported favorably. Rules suspended. Read by title and referred to the Legislative Bureau.

- Reported without Legislative Bureau amendments. Read by title and passed to third reading and final passage.

HB95 Leger TAX/INCOME TAX

Repeals the state income tax deduction for federal income taxes paid for purposes of calculating corporate income taxes (Item #17)

- Read by title and returned to the Calendar, subject to call.

HB99 Stokes TAX/CORP INCOME

Provides relative to the apportionment ratio for purposes of computing corporate income tax (Item #5)

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- Senate floor amendments read and adopted.
- The amended bill was read by title and returned to the Calendar, subject to call.

HB116 Ivey TAX/CORP INCOME
Provides relative to loss years for purposes of the net operating loss deduction for corporate income tax (Item #5)

- Read by title and returned to the Calendar, subject to call.

HB122 Henry APPROPRIATIONS/SUPPLEML
Supplemental appropriations and reductions in appropriations for Fiscal Year 2015-2016 (Item #1)

- Reported with amendments. Rules suspended. Committee amendments read and adopted. Read by title and referred to the Legislative Bureau.
- Reported without Legislative Bureau amendments. Read by title and passed to third reading and final passage.
