- SB9 Donahue FUNDS/FUNDING  
Provides relative to funds in the state treasury and certain fund tranfers. (gov sig)  
- Read by title, passed by a vote of 36 yeas and 0 nays, and sent to the House. Motion to reconsider tabled.
- SB25 Cortez FUNDS/FUNDING  
Sunsets all sales and use tax exemptions other than those that are constitutionally protected. (Item #36)(7/1/17)  
- Called from the Calendar.  
- Senate floor amendments read and adopted. Read by title and passed by a vote of 37 yeas and 1 nays; ordered reengrossed and sent to the House. Motion to reconsider tabled.
- HB14 Leger TAX/TOBACCO TAX  
Levies an additional tax on cigarettes (Item #4)  
- Read by title, passed by a vote of 33 yeas and 2 nays, and ordered returned to the House. Motion to reconsider tabled.
- HB18 Montoucet TAX/TOBACCO TAX  
Reduces the amount of the discount for accurately reporting and remitting excise taxes on certain tobacco products and the amount of the discount for stamping cigarettes (Item #22)  
- Read by title, passed by a vote of 35 yeas and 1 nays, and ordered returned to the House. Motion to reconsider tabled.
- HB19 James TAX/CORP FRANCHISE  
Provides relative to the entities to which corporate franchise tax applies (Item #28)  
- Reported favorably. Rules suspended. Read by title and referred to the Legislative Bureau.  
- Reported without Legislative Bureau amendments. Read by title and passed to third reading and final passage.
- HB28 Cox TAX/ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGE  
Reduces the amount of the discount for accurately reporting and remitting excise taxes on alcoholic beverages and beer (Item #23)  
- Reported with amendments. Rules suspended. Committee amendments read and adopted. Read by title and referred to the Legislative Bureau.  
- Reported without Legislative Bureau amendments. Read by title and passed to third reading and final passage.
- HB71 Barras TAX CREDITS  
Reduces the amount of certain Enterprise Zone tax credits and removes certain hotels from eligibility (Item #27)  
- Reported with amendments. Rules suspended. Committee amendments read and adopted. Read by title and referred to the Legislative Bureau.  
- Reported without Legislative Bureau amendments. Read by title and passed to third reading and final passage.
- HB111 Marcelle FUNDS/FUNDING  
To eliminate the Debt Recovery Fund (Item #7)  
- The amended bill was read by title, passed by a vote of 36 yeas and 1 nays, and ordered returned to the House. Motion to reconsider tabled.
- HB118 Barras APPROPRIATIONS/SUPPLEML  
Reduces appropriations for the Louisiana Judiciary for Fiscal Year 2015-2016 (Item #1)  
- Read by title, passed by a vote of 37 yeas and 0 nays, and ordered returned to the House.
