- SB15 Morrell TAX/TAXATION
Provides relative to the application of refundable tax credits. (Item #26)(gov sig)
- Amendments proposed by the House read and rejected by a vote of 37 yeas and 0 nays.
 - Senate conference committee members appointed: Morrell, Erdey, and Lambert.
 - Notice House Conference Committee members appointed.
 - Conference Committee Report read; adopted by a vote of 33 yeas and 4 nays.

- SB22 Morrell TAX EXEMPTIONS
Modifies the sales and use tax exemption for domed stadium facilities, baseball facilities, and other publicly owned facilities. (Item #36)(gov sig)

- SCR8 Morrell TAX/INCOME/CORPORATE
Clarifies the intent of the Legislature that Act 108 of the 2015 Regular Session is to apply prospectively only.
- Amendments proposed by the House read and concurred in by a vote of 37 yeas and 0 nays.
- HB2 Broadwater TAX CREDITS
Repeals the Student Assessment for a Valuable Education (SAVE) credit program (Item #14)
- Rules suspended. Called from the Calendar.
 - Senate floor amendments read and adopted. Read by title, passed by a vote of 39 yeas and 0 nays, and ordered returned to the House. Motion to reconsider tabled.
 - Signed by the President of the Senate.
- HB19 James TAX/CORP FRANCHISE
Provides relative to the entities to which corporate franchise tax applies (Item #28)
- Rules suspended. Called from the Calendar.
 - Senate floor amendments read and adopted.
 - Read by title and returned to the Calendar, subject to call.
 - Rules suspended. Called from the Calendar.
 - Senate floor amendments read and adopted. Read by title, passed by a vote of 26 yeas and 9 nays, and ordered returned to the House. Motion to reconsider tabled.
 - Signed by the President of the Senate.
- HB22 Jackson TAX/TAX REBATES
Repeals the three-year sunset of certain reductions to tax rebates (Item #11)
- Notice House rejected the Senate amendments.
 - Notice House Conference Committee members appointed.
 - Senate conference committee members appointed: Morrell, LaFleur, and Martiny.
 - Conference Committee Report read; adopted by a vote of 22 yeas and 15 nays.

HB57 Stokes TAX CREDITS
Repeals three-year sunset on certain eligibility requirements relative to the income tax credit for net taxes paid to other states (Item #13)

HB59 Moreno TAX/SALES-USE, STATE
Provides relative to imposition of the state sales and use tax on hotels (Items #9 and 30)

HB61 Morris, Jay TAX/SALES & USE
To provide with respect to the applicability of certain exclusions and exemptions from state sales and use taxes

- Senate floor amendments read and adopted. Read by title, passed by a vote of 36 yeas and 2 nays, and ordered returned to the House. Motion to reconsider tabled.
- Notice the House rejected the Senate amendments; House Conference Committee members appointed.

HB62 Jackson TAX/SALES-USE, STATE
Impose a one cent sales and use tax (Item #9)

HB71 Barras TAX CREDITS
Reduces the amount of certain Enterprise Zone tax credits and removes certain hotels from eligibility (Item #27)

HB75 Stokes TAX/INCOME TAX
Changes the rates and brackets for purposes of calculating individual income tax liability and eliminates certain deductions (Item #3)

- Senate floor amendments read and adopted. Read by title, passed by a vote of 20 yeas and 16 nays, and ordered returned to the House. Motion to reconsider tabled.

HB76 Stokes TAX/INCOME TAX
(Constitutional Amendment) Eliminates the income tax deduction for federal income taxes paid for purposes of computing individual and corporate income taxes and references to the maximum amount of individual income tax rates and brackets (Item #3)
