- SB1 Gatti TAX EXEMPTIONS
Restores sales tax exemption for admissions to athletic and entertainment events for elementary and secondary schools. (7/1/16)(Item No. 7)
- Read second time by title and referred to the Committee on Revenue and Fiscal Affairs.
- SB2 Morrell TAX/TAXATION
Provides for interest paid on refunds of tax overpayments. (Item No. 45) (7/1/16)
- Read second time by title and referred to the Committee on Revenue and Fiscal Affairs.
- SB3 Morrell TAX/TAXATION
Provides with respect to exemptions from state sales tax. (Item Nos. 7-35) (7/1/16)
- Read second time by title and referred to the Committee on Revenue and Fiscal Affairs.
- SB4 Chabert TAX EXEMPTIONS
Legislates with regard to purchases of fishing boats, supply fuels, lubricants and repairs for the boats of licensed commercial fisherman. (7/1/16) (Item No. 33)
- Read second time by title and referred to the Committee on Revenue and Fiscal Affairs.
- SB5 Chabert TAX EXEMPTIONS
Legislates with regard to sales of butane, propane, or other liquified petroleum gases for private, residential consumption. (7/1/16)(Item No. 34)
- Read second time by title and referred to the Committee on Revenue and Fiscal Affairs.
- SB6 Morrell TAX/AD VALOREM
Provides for the carry forward rather than the refund of a certain portion of the tax credit for ad valorem taxes paid on inventory. (gov sig) (Item #47)
- Read second time by title and referred to the Committee on Revenue and Fiscal Affairs.
- SB7 Morrell TAX/TAXATION
Provides for increases to the earned income tax credit. (See Act) (Item No. 47)
- Read second time by title and referred to the Committee on Revenue and Fiscal Affairs.
- SB8 Morrell TAX/TAXATION
Provides for the operability of the tax credit for Citizens Property Insurance Corporation 2005 assessment. (gov sig) (Item Nos. 46 and 47)
- Read second time by title and referred to the Committee on Revenue and Fiscal Affairs.
- SB9 Morrell TAX/SALES
Provides for a definition of isolated and occasional sales for sales and use tax. (7/1/16) (Item No. 16)
- Read second time by title and referred to the Committee on Revenue and Fiscal Affairs.
- SCR1 Long LEGISLATIVE SESSIONS
Invites the governor to address a joint session of the legislature on Tuesday, June 7, 2016, at 10:00 a.m.
- Received from the House without amendments.
- SR3 Riser SENATE
