Provides for the Omnibus Bond Act (Item #4)
- Read by title, passed by a vote of 34 yeas and 1 nays, and ordered returned to the House. Motion to reconsider tabled.
- HB51 Morris, Jim TAX/SALES-USE, STATE
Provides with respect to the effectiveness of certain exclusions and exemptions from state sales and use taxes (Items #7-34)
- Read by title and returned to the Calendar, subject to call.
- HB52 Abramson CAPITAL OUTLAY
Provides with respect to the execution and administration of capital outlay appropriations for Fiscal Year 2016-2017 (Item #3)
