- SB6 Morrell TAX/AD VALOREM
Provides for the carry forward rather than the refund of a certain portion of the tax credit for ad valorem taxes paid on inventory. (gov sig) (Item #47)
- Amendments proposed by the House read and rejected by a vote of 34 yeas and 4 nays.
- SB10 Ward TAX/AD VALOREM
Provides for the confidentiality of tax records and the definitions of inventory and manufacturer for purposes of the tax credits for ad valorem taxes paid to local governments. (See Act) (Item #47)
- Amendments proposed by the House read and rejected by a vote of 33 yeas and 4 nays.
- SB15 Morrell TAX EXEMPTIONS
Provides for an annual reporting requirement by certain nonprofit entities for certain sales tax exemptions. (7/1/16) (Item Nos. 7, 8, 11, 12, 14, 15, 19-24, 32)
- Amendments proposed by the House read and concurred in by a vote of 29 yeas and 9 nays.
