Provides relative to facilities providing housing to individuals referred by judicial agencies. (8/1/16)

Provides relative to the judicial district indigent defender fund. (gov sig)

Requires publication of certain contracts and reports on the Internet and and creates task force which is authorized to study and make annual assessments of state contracts. (7/1/16)

Provides relative to leases or subleases of immovable property owned, leased or controlled by a public benefit corporation. (gov sig)

Provides that Smart Growth Developments include amenities which enhance the quality of life for its residents. (gov sig)
