Finally passed, title adopted, ordered to the Senate.</li></ul>
HB16	Echols	TAX CREDITS	Establishes a tax credit for eligible expenses incurred in the rehabilitation of historic structures included on the National Register of Historic Places (Item #19) <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>- Reported with amendments (12-0).</li></ul>
HB17	Bishop, S.	TAX/CORP FRANCHISE	Suspends the corporation franchise tax levied on certain taxable capital and suspends the initial corporation franchise tax levied on certain entities (Item #16) <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>- Read by title, ordered engrossed, passed to 3rd reading.</li><li>- Scheduled for floor debate on 06/16/20.</li></ul>

HB21 Magee COMMERCIAL REGULATIONS  
Provides relative to motor vehicle repairs (Item #39)

- Read third time by title, roll called on final passage, yeas 95, nays 0. Finally passed, title adopted, ordered to the Senate.

HB23 Dwight TAX/AD VALOREM TAX  
(Constitutional Amendment) Authorizes certain agreements that provide for payments in lieu of ad valorem taxes (Item #28)

- Read by title, ordered engrossed, recommitted to the Committee on Civil Law and Procedure.

HB26 Zeringue COLLEGES/UNIVERSITIES  
Extends, with limitations, the authority of public postsecondary education management boards to establish and increase student fees (Item #41)

- Reported with amendments (13-0).

HB27 Zeringue COURTS/COURT REPORTERS  
Provides relative to the creation of the certified shorthand reporters fund (Items #10 and #11)

- Read third time by title, amended, roll called on final passage, yeas 67, nays 19. The bill, not having received two-thirds vote of the elected members, failed to pass. Motion to reconsider pending.

- Read third time by title, amended, roll called on final passage, yeas 85, nays 0. The bill, having received two-thirds vote of the elected members, was finally passed, title adopted, ordered to the Senate.

HB28 Dwight TAX/AD VALOREM TAX  
Authorizes agreements between political subdivisions and taxpayers that may provide for certain payments in lieu of ad valorem taxes (Item #28)

- Read by title, ordered engrossed, passed to 3rd reading.
- Scheduled for floor debate on 06/16/20.

HB34 Echols FUNDS/FUNDING  
Creates the Louisiana Opioid Settlement Fund (Item #11)

- Read by title, amended, returned to the calendar.
- Notice given.
- Scheduled for floor debate on 06/15/20.

HB35 Bishop, S. FUNDS/FUNDING  
Creates the Capital Outlay Savings Fund (Items #10 and #11)

- Read by title, ordered engrossed, passed to 3rd reading.
- Scheduled for floor debate on 06/16/20.

HB36 Ivey TAX/AD VALOREM-EXEMPTION

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(Constitutional Amendment) Establishes certain property tax exemptions for capital investment projects (Item #28)

HB37 Harris, Lance REVENUE DEPARTMENT

Requires the Department of Revenue to waive penalties and interest for certain taxpayers for tax years 2019 and 2020 (Item #29)

HB39 Davis UTILITIES

Provides relative to the Louisiana Electric Utility Investment Recovery Securitization Act (Item #35)

HB41 Ivey TAX/AD VALOREM TAX

(Constitutional Amendment) Establishes an ad valorem tax exemption for capital investment projects and for certain property subject to a cooperative endeavor agreement requiring the property owner to make payments in lieu of taxes (Item #28)

- Read by title, amended, ordered engrossed, recommitted to the Committee on Civil Law and Procedure.

HB50 Ivey TAX/AD VALOREM TAX

Authorizes local taxing authorities to enter into cooperative endeavor agreements that provide for payments in lieu of taxes (Item #28)

- Reported with amendments (11-0).

HB51 Jordan CIVIL/IMMUNITY

Provides with respect to immunity from civil liability for law enforcement engaged in certain actions (Item #40)

- Rules suspended.
- Called from the calendar.
- Read by title, referred to the Committee on Civil Law and Procedure.

HB52 Coussan TAX CREDITS

Increases the amount of the Digital Interactive Media and Software Tax Credit, requires the increase to be used for training employees from certain disadvantaged groups, and expands eligibility to include information technology services (Item #19)

- Reported with amendments (15-0).

HB54 Ivey TAX/AD VALOREM-EXEMPTION

Provides for ad valorem tax exemptions for certain capital investment projects (Item # 28)

- Reported with amendments (11-0).

HB62 Zeringue UNEMPLOYMENT COMP

Provides for state income tax withholdings on unemployment compensation benefits (Item #32)

- Read by title, under the rules, referred to the Committee on Labor and Industrial Relations.

HB63 Wright MOTOR VEHICLES

Provides relative to ignition interlock devices and maintenance services (Item #39)

- Read by title, returned to the calendar.

HB64 Stefanski TAX/GAMING

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Levies a state tax on the net revenue of fantasy sports contests (Item #17)

- Reported favorably (13-0).

HB65 Wright EMPLOYMENT

Requires short-term COVID-19 occupational forecasts (Item #15)

- Read by title, under the rules, referred to the Committee on Labor and Industrial Relations.

HB66 Nelson CIVIL/ACTIONS

Enacts the Citizens' Premium Reduction Act (Item #40)

- Read by title, under the rules, referred to the Committee on Civil Law and Procedure.

HB67 Crews HEALTH SERVICES

Provides for transparency in health services pricing by in-network and out-of-network healthcare providers (Item #37)

- Read by title. Lies over under the rules.

HB68 Deshotel TAX CREDITS

Establishes an income or corporation franchise tax credit for certain broadband coverage providers (Item #31)

- Read by title. Lies over under the rules.

HB69 Deshotel TAX/SALES-USE-EXEMPT

To provide for a sales and use tax exemption on the sales of certain fiber-optic cables (Item #31)

HCR5 Freeman LEGISLATIVE AFFAIRS

Requests a study of the continuity of government provisions by the house and senate governmental affairs committees, meeting jointly

HCR6 Wright U.S. CONSTITUTION

Calls for a convention to amend the United States Constitution to establish a limitation on terms for members of congress

Requires all fiscal notes to be requested via email and requires the name of the person who requested the fiscal note to appear on the face of the fiscal note
