- HB2 Bishop, S. CAPITAL OUTLAY  
 Provides for the comprehensive Capital Outlay budget (Item #7)  
 - Sent to the Governor for executive approval.
- HB11 Stefanski TAX/SALES & USE  
 Provides for the amount of compensation persons required to collect state sales and use tax may deduct for remitting taxes (Item #30)  
 - Read third time by title, roll called on final passage, yeas 88, nays 3. Finally passed, title adopted, ordered to the Senate.
- HB13 Wright TAX CREDITS  
 Authorizes certain retail businesses to participate in the Enterprise Zone incentive (Item #18)  
 - Read third time by title, roll called on final passage, yeas 62, nays 32. Finally passed, title adopted, ordered to the Senate.
- HB17 Bishop, S. TAX/CORP FRANCHISE  
 Suspends the corporation franchise tax levied on certain taxable capital and suspends the initial corporation franchise tax levied on certain entities (Item #16)  
 - Read third time by title, amended, roll called on final passage, yeas 67, nays 25. The bill, not having received two-thirds vote of the elected members, failed to pass. Motion to reconsider pending.
- HB19 Pressly TAX/TAX REBATES  
 Extends eligibility requirements for certain industries to participate in the Quality Jobs Program (Item #18)  
 - Read third time by title, roll called on final passage, yeas 68, nays 26. Finally passed, title adopted, ordered to the Senate.
- HB25 Wright TAX/CORP INCOME  
 Authorizes carry-back provisions for the net operating loss deduction for purposes of calculating corporate income tax (Item #20)  
 - Read by title, amended, ordered engrossed, recommitted to the Committee on Appropriations.
- HB28 Dwight TAX/AD VALOREM TAX  
 Authorizes agreements between political subdivisions and taxpayers that may provide for certain payments in lieu of ad valorem taxes (Item #28)  
 - Read by title, returned to the calendar.
- HB34 Echols FUNDS/FUNDING  
 Creates the Louisiana Opioid Settlement Fund (Item #11)  
 - Read by title, returned to the calendar.
- HB35 Bishop, S. FUNDS/FUNDING  
 Creates the Capital Outlay Savings Fund (Items #10 and #11)  
 - Read third time by title, amended, roll called on final passage, yeas 93, nays 5. Finally passed, title adopted, ordered to the Senate.
- HB37 Harris, Lance REVENUE DEPARTMENT  
 Requires the Department of Revenue to waive penalties and interest for certain taxpayers for tax years 2019 and 2020 (Item #29)  
 - Read third time by title, amended, roll called on final passage, yeas 90, nays 2. Finally passed, title adopted, ordered to the Senate.

HB69 Deshotel TAX/SALES-USE-EXEMPT  
To provide for a sales and use tax exemption on the sale of certain fiber-optic cables (Item #31)  
- Read by title, amended, ordered engrossed, passed to 3rd reading.

HB70 Jenkins TAX/TAX REBATES  
Extends Enterprise Zone Program incentives to essential critical infrastructure workers by authorizing the payment of a one-time hazard pay rebate (Item #18)

HB71 Duplessis FUNDS/FUNDING  
Provides for a death benefit for certain public employees who die from COVID-19 (Item #11)  
- Read by title. Lies over under the rules.

HB72 Crews INSURANCE/HEALTH  
Provides relative to billing by noncontracted facility-based physicians (Item #37)  
- Read by title. Lies over under the rules.

HCR5 Freeman LEGISLATIVE AFFAIRS  
Requests a study of the continuity of government provisions by the house and senate governmental

- HCR7 Ivey LEGISLATIVE AGCY/LAW INST  
Directs the Louisiana State Law Institute to study the Constitution of Louisiana and make recommendations to the legislature regarding transitional and outdated language that can be removed or changed without affecting the effect of the constitutional provisions
- Read by title, ordered engrossed, passed to 3rd reading.
  - Scheduled for floor debate on 06/18/20.
- HCR8 James JOINT RULES  
Requires all fiscal notes to be requested in writing and requires the name of the person who requested the fiscal note to appear on the face of the fiscal note
- Read by title, amended, roll called on final consideration, yeas 95, nays 1. The resolution was adopted and ordered to the Senate.
- HCR11 Fontenot COASTAL RES/COASTAL ZONE  
Memorializes the U.S. Congress and the Louisiana congressional delegation to remove the revenue sharing cap on the Gulf of Mexico Energy Securities Act of 2006 for Gulf producing states and to take such actions as are necessary to rectify the federal revenue sharing inequities between energy producing states
- Read by title, roll called on final consideration, yeas 94, nays 0. The resolution was adopted and ordered to the Senate.
- HCR12 Garofalo WORKFORCE DEVELOPMENT  
Directs the Louisiana Workforce Investment Council to study and submit a report to the legislature relative to funding and programs for workforce development
- Rules suspended, called out of its regular order.
  - Read by title, roll called on final consideration, yeas 70, nays 21. The resolution was adopted and ordered to the Senate.
- HCR17 Carpenter EMPLOYMENT  
Requests certain state agencies and private businesses to recognize the value that justice-involved persons bring to the workforce and society, and to act with the intention to empower, train, and employ such individuals
