The bill, having received two-thirds vote of the elected members, was finally passed, title adopted, ordered to the Senate.

SB9 Hewitt EVIDENCE
Provides relative to safety belts. (Item #40) (1/1/21)

SB10 Mizell INTERNET
Provides relative to rural broadband high-speed internet access. (Item #31) (gov sig)

SB11 Fesi FRAUD
Provides relative to civil liability and certain actions for nullity involving fraud. (Item #40) (See Act)

SB12 Fesi UNCLAIMED PROPERTY
Constitutional amendment to dedicate unclaimed property funds and to create the Louisiana Unclaimed Property Permanent Trust Fund. (2/3 - CA13s1(A)) (Item #10) (7/1/21)

- Received in the House from the Senate, read by title, lies over under the rules.

Provides for cooperative endeavor agreements between local governmental subdivisions and other entities that may require payments in lieu of ad valorem taxes. (Item #28) (See Act)

 - Read by title, passed to 3rd reading.
 - Scheduled for floor debate on 06/24/20.
- SB17 Hewitt TAX/TAXATION
Provides relative to the Angel Investor Tax Credit Program. (Item #19) (8/1/20)
 - Reported without Legislative Bureau amendments.
 - Read by title, passed to 3rd reading.
 - Scheduled for floor debate on 06/24/20.
- SB18 Fesi FUNDS/FUNDING
Dedication of unclaimed property funds and creation of Louisiana Unclaimed Property Permanent Trust Fund. (Item #10) (See Act)
 - Received in the House from the Senate, read by title, lies over under the rules.
 - Rules suspended.
 - Read by title, under the rules, referred to the Committee on Appropriations.
- SB19 Peacock FUNDS/FUNDING
Provides for investment authority of the Treasurer for the Millennium Trust, the Rockefeller Wildlife Refuge Trust and Protection Fund, and the Russell Sage or Marsh Island Trust Fund. (Item #10) (7/1/20)
 - Reported favorably (15-0). Referred to the Legislative Bureau.
- SB26 Hewitt ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT
Provides for an extension of the application deadline for the Quality Jobs Program. (Item #18) (7/1/20)
 - Reported without Legislative Bureau amendments.
 - Read by title, passed to 3rd reading.
 - Scheduled for floor debate on 06/24/20.
- SCR3 Mills, Robert INSURANCE RATES
Creates the Task Force on Log Truck and Agriculture Vehicle Liability Insurance.
 - Discharged from the Committee on House and Governmental Affairs.
 - Read by title, passed to 3rd reading.
 - Scheduled for floor debate on 06/24/20.
- SCR7 Fields LEGIS POWERS/FUNCTIONS
Establishes the Police Training, Screening, and De-esclation Task Force to study and make recommendations to the legislature.
