SB24	Harris, Jimmy	TAX/TAXATION	Provides for eligibility for the Angel Investor Tax Credit for investments made in federal opportunity zones. (Item #19) (gov sig) - Read by title, passed by a vote of 36 yeas and 1 nays, and sent to the House. Motion to reconsider tabled.
SB27	White, B	STATE AGENCIES	Creates and provides for the Streamlining Government Commission. (Item #33) (gov sig) - Read by title, passed by a vote of 37 yeas and 0 nays, and sent to the House. Motion to reconsider tabled.
SCR4	Foil	TAX/TAXATION	Requests the study of the feasibility of establishing a tax credit program as a funding mechanism for public-private partnership investment in Louisiana infrastructure projects. - Enrolled. Signed by the President of the Senate.
SCR23	Foil	SPECIAL DAY/WEEK/MONTH	Declares April 2nd as World Autism Day in Louisiana, annually. - Read by title and adopted by a vote of 35 yeas and 0 nays. Ordered sent to the House.
SCR24	Cathey	CONDOLENCES	Expresses condolences upon the death of Philip Andrew "Andy" Trahan Jr. and posthumously commends him for his lung cancer advocacy and mentorship. - Introduced in the Senate. Read by title and placed on the Calendar for a second reading.

HB13 Wright TAX CREDITS  
Authorizes certain retail businesses to participate in the Enterprise Zone incentive (Item #18)

Creates the Capital Outlay Savings Fund (Items #10 and #11)  
- Senate floor amendments read and adopted.  
- Read by title and returned to the Calendar, subject to call.
- HB37 Harris, Lance REVENUE DEPARTMENT  
Requires the Department of Revenue to waive penalties and interest for certain taxpayers for tax years 2019 and 2020 (Item #29)  
- Senate floor amendments read and adopted. Read by title, passed by a vote of 36 yeas and 0 nays, and ordered returned to the House. Motion to reconsider tabled.
- HB41 Ivey TAX/AD VALOREM TAX  
(Constitutional Amendment) Establishes an ad valorem tax exemption for capital investment projects and for certain property subject to a cooperative endeavor agreement requiring the property owner to make payments in lieu of taxes (Item #28)  
- Received in the Senate. Rules suspended. Read first time by title and placed on the Calendar for a second reading.
- HB59 Mincey LIABILITY/PUBLIC  
Provides relative to limitations of liability for public and private school districts and postsecondary institutions during a declared state of emergency or a public health emergency (Item #40)  
- Received in the Senate. Read first time by title and placed on the Calendar for a second reading.
- HB64 Stefanski TAX/GAMING  
Levies a state tax on the net revenue of fantasy sports contests (Item #17)  
- Read by title, passed by a vote of 36 yeas and 0 nays, and ordered returned to the House. Motion to reconsider tabled.
- HB66 Nelson CIVIL/ACTIONS  
Enacts the Citizens' Premium Reduction Act (Item #40)  
- Received in the Senate. Read first time by title and placed on the Calendar for a second reading.
- HCR5 Freeman LEGISLATIVE AFFAIRS  
Requests a study of the continuity of government provisions by the house and senate governmental affairs committees, meeting jointly  
- Read by title and concurred in by a vote of 37 yeas and 0 nays. Ordered returned to the House.
- HCR6 Wright U.S. CONSTITUTION  
Calls for a convention to amend the United States Constitution to establish a limitation on terms for members of congress  
- Read by title and returned to the Calendar, subject to call.
- HCR18 Seabaugh MTR VEHICLE/SEAT BELTS  
Suspends provisions relative to safety belt evidence (Item #40)  
- Received in the Senate. Read first time by title and placed on the Calendar for a second reading.
- HCR19 Seabaugh CIVIL/ACTIONS  
Suspends provisions of law relative to direct actions against insurers (Item #40)
