HB35 Bishop, S. FUNDS/FUNDING
Creates the Capital Outlay Savings Fund (Items #10 and #11)

HB41 Ivey TAX/AD VALOREM TAX
(Constitutional Amendment) Establishes an ad valorem tax exemption for capital investment projects and for certain property subject to a cooperative endeavor agreement requiring the property owner to make payments in lieu of taxes (Item #28)

- Read second time by title and referred to the Committee on Revenue and Fiscal Affairs.

HB50 Ivey TAX/AD VALOREM TAX
Authorizes local taxing authorities to enter into cooperative endeavor agreements that provide for payments in lieu of taxes (Item #28)

- Reported favorably.

HB57 Schexnayder CIVIL/ACTIONS
Enacts the Civil Justice Reform Act of 2020 (Item #40)

- Notice House rejected the Senate amendments.
- Notice House Conference Committee members appointed.
- Senate conference committee members appointed: Cortez, Peacock, and Luneau.

HB59 Mincey LIABILITY/PUBLIC
Provides relative to limitations of liability for public and private school districts and postsecondary institutions during a declared state of emergency or a public health emergency (Item #40)

- Read second time by title and referred to the Committee on Education.

HB66 Nelson CIVIL/ACTIONS
Enacts the Citizens' Premium Reduction Act (Item #40)

- Read second time by title and referred to the Committee on Judiciary A.

HB69 Deshotel TAX/SALES-USE-EXEMPT
To provide for a sales and use tax exemption on the sale of certain fiber-optic cables (Item #31)

- Reported with amendments.

HB70 Jenkins TAX/TAX REBATES
Extends Enterprise Zone Program incentives to essential critical infrastructure workers by authorizing the payment of a one-time hazard pay rebate (Item #18)

- Reported with amendments.

HB71 Duplessis FUNDS/FUNDING
Provides for a death benefit for certain public employees who die from COVID-19 (Item #11)

- Received in the Senate. Read first time by title and placed on the Calendar for a second reading.

HCR1 Zeringue FUNDS/FUNDING
Provides for monies in the Budget Stabilization Fund to be available for appropriation in Fiscal Year 2020-2021 (Item #14)
