- SB17 Hewitt TAX/TAXATION
Provides relative to the Angel Investor Tax Credit Program. (Item #19) (8/1/20)
- Enrolled. Signed by the President of the Senate.
- SB18 Fesi FUNDS/FUNDING
Dedication of unclaimed property funds and creation of Louisiana Unclaimed Property Permanent Trust Fund. (Item #10) (See Act)
- Received from the House with amendments.
- SB19 Peacock FUNDS/FUNDING
Provides for investment authority of the Treasurer for the Millennium Trust, the Rockefeller Wildlife Refuge Trust and Protection Fund, and the Russell Sage or Marsh Island Trust Fund. (Item #10) (7/1/20)

Creates the Task Force on Log Truck and Agriculture Vehicle Liability Insurance.

SCR27

Boudreaux HEALTH DEPARTMENT

Directs the Louisiana Department of Health to seek independent consultant opinions and alternative options for the submission of the Managed Care Section 438.6(c) Preprint to CMS for FY22 prior to finalization.

Jackson INSURANCE DEPARTMENT

HB50 Ivey TAX/AD VALOREM TAX

Authorizes local taxing authorities to enter into cooperative endeavor agreements that provide for payments in lieu of taxes (Item #28)

Provides relative to evidence of causation from nonuse of a safety belt (Item #40)

- HB64 Stefanski TAX/GAMING

To provide for a sales and use tax exemption on the sale of certain fiber-optic cables (Item #31)

- HB70 Jenkins TAX/TAX REBATES
Extends Enterprise Zone Program incentives to essential critical infrastructure workers by authorizing the payment of a one-time hazard pay rebate (Item #18)
- Committee amendments read and adopted. Read by title and referred to the Legislative Bureau.
- Reported without Legislative Bureau amendments. Read by title and passed to third reading and final passage.
- HB71 Duplessis FUNDS/FUNDING
Provides for a death benefit for certain public employees who die from COVID-19 (Item #11)

- HCR1 Zeringue FUNDS/FUNDING
Provides for monies in the Budget Stabilization Fund to be available for appropriation in Fiscal Year 2020-2021 (Item #14)
- Reported without Legislative Bureau amendments. Read by title and passed to third reading and final passage.
- HCR2 Schexnayder HOSPITALS
Provides for a hospital stabilization formula (Item #12)
- Senate Committee amendments read and adopted.
- Reported without Legislative Bureau amendments. Read by title and passed to third reading and final passage.
- HCR5 Freeman LEGISLATIVE AFFAIRS
Requests a study of the continuity of government provisions by the house and senate governmental affairs committees, meeting jointly

Directs the Louisiana State Law Institute to study the Constitution of Louisiana and make recommendations to the legislature regarding transitional and outdated language that can be removed or changed without affecting the effect of the constitutional provisions

- HCR12 Garofalo WORKFORCE DEVELOPMENT
Directs the Louisiana Workforce Investment Council to study and submit a report to the legislature relative to funding and programs for workforce development
- Reported with amendments.
- HCR17 Carpenter EMPLOYMENT
Requests certain state agencies and private businesses to recognize the value that justice-involved persons bring to the workforce and society, and to act with the intention to empower, train, and employ such individuals
- Reported with amendments.
- HCR25 Schexnayder LEGISLATIVE FISCAL OFF
Provides for the election of the legislative fiscal officer of the Legislature of Louisiana
- Received in the Senate. Read first time by title and placed on the Calendar for a second reading.
- HCR26 Brown, Chad INSURANCE/HEALTH
Requests a joint subcommittee of the House Committee on Insurance and Senate Committee on Insurance to undertake a study to make recommendations for proposed legislation relative to balance or surprise billing in Louisiana

- HCR27 Hilferty MENTAL HEALTH
Requests a study by the respective legislative committees to study the rights of caregivers and the establishment of a "caregivers' bill of rights" for family members, legal guardians, and other persons who provide care for persons with serious mental illness
