- SCR22 Carter, Troy CONGRESS
Memorializes Congress to extend the certification for an 8(a) business by one additional year if the business was certified by January 1, 2020.
 - Enrolled. Signed by the President of the Senate.
- SCR28 Jackson INSURANCE DEPARTMENT
Requests that the Department of Insurance study and report on approaches taken by other southern states to reduce automobile insurance premiums, report statistics obtained by the insurance fraud investigation unit, and advise as to ways to increase the number of automobile insurers writing policies in the state and to report that information to the legislative Task Force on Available and Affordable Automobile Insurance.

Requests the Louisiana Gaming Control Board to report on the fiscal impact of the promotional play exception to the definitions of net gaming proceeds, gross revenue, and net slot machine proceeds.
