Provides for the ancillary expenses of state government (Item #5)
- Signed by the President of the Senate.
- HB19 Pressly TAX/TAX REBATES
Extends eligibility requirements for certain industries to participate in the Quality Jobs Program (Item #18)
- Rules suspended. Called from the Calendar.
- Senate floor amendments read and adopted. Read by title, passed by a vote of 28 yeas and 9 nays, and ordered returned to the House. Motion to reconsider tabled.
- HB29 Zeringue APPROPRIATIONS/SUPPLEML
Makes supplemental appropriations for Fiscal Year 2019-2020 (Item #2)
- Notice House rejected the Senate amendments.
- Notice House Conference Committee members appointed.

- HB35 Bishop, S. FUNDS/FUNDING
Creates the Capital Outlay Savings Fund (Items #10 and #11)
- Signed by the President of the Senate.
- HB55 Johnson, Mike MTR VEHICLE/SEAT BELTS
Provides relative to evidence of causation from nonuse of a safety belt (Item #40)
- Signed by the President of the Senate.
- HB57 Schexnayder CIVIL/ACTIONS
Enacts the Civil Justice Reform Act of 2020 (Item #40)
- Conference Committee Report read; adopted by a vote of 30 yeas and 8 nays.
- HB59 Mincey LIABILITY/PUBLIC
Provides relative to limitations of liability for public and private school districts and postsecondary institutions during a declared state of emergency or a public health emergency (Item #40)
- Rules suspended. Senate floor amendments read and adopted. Read by title, passed by a vote of 33 yeas and 2 nays, and ordered returned to the House. Motion to reconsider tabled.
- HB62 Zeringue UNEMPLOYMENT COMP
Provides for state income tax withholdings on unemployment compensation benefits (Item #32)

- HB66 Nelson CIVIL/ACTIONS
Enacts the Citizens' Premium Reduction Act (Item #40)
- Rules suspended. Senate floor amendments read and adopted. Read by title, passed by a vote of 35 yeas and 3 nays, and ordered returned to the House. Motion to reconsider tabled.
- HB69 Deshotel TAX/TAX REBATES
To provide for a sales and use tax rebate on the sale of certain fiber-optic cable equipment (Item #31)
- Signed by the President of the Senate.
- HB70 Jenkins TAX/TAX REBATES
Extends Enterprise Zone Program incentives to essential critical infrastructure workers by authorizing the payment of a one-time hazard pay rebate (Item #18)
- Signed by the President of the Senate.
- HCR7 Ivey LEGISLATIVE AGCY/LAW INST
Directs the Louisiana State Law Institute to study the Constitution of Louisiana and make recommendations to the legislature regarding transitional and outdated language that can be removed or changed without affecting the effect of the constitutional provisions

- HCR10 Bagley SCHOOLS/BUS OPERATORS
Requests governing authorities of public schools to continue operational pay for school bus operators during emergencies
- Signed by the President of the Senate.
- HCR12 Garofalo WORKFORCE DEVELOPMENT
Directs the Louisiana Workforce Investment Council to study and submit a report to the legislature relative to funding and programs for workforce development
- Signed by the President of the Senate.
- HCR17 Carpenter EMPLOYMENT
Requests certain state agencies and private businesses to recognize the value that justice-involved persons bring to the workforce and society, and to act with the intention to empower, train, and employ such individuals
- Signed by the President of the Senate.
- HCR25 Schexnayder LEGISLATIVE FISCAL OFF
Provides for the election of the legislative fiscal officer of the Legislature of Louisiana
- Signed by the President of the Senate.
- HCR26 Brown, Chad INSURANCE/HEALTH
Requests a joint subcommittee of the House Committee on Insurance and Senate Committee on Insurance to undertake a study to make recommendations for proposed legislation relative to balance or surprise billing in Louisiana
- Signed by the President of the Senate.
