- SB258 Carter, Troy LAW ENFORCEMENT  
Provides relative to minimum requirements for annual vacation and sick leave for the employees of the city of Westwego Police Department. (2/3 - CA10s18) (gov sig)

- SB270 Fields COURTS  
Provides that jurors be paid an amount equal to the amount that jurors in federal cases receive. (1/1/21)

Provides for registration with secretary of state by managed service providers servicing public bodies. (See Act)
