- SB104 Milligan MUSEUMS
Provides for board membership and authority of certain state museums. (gov sig)
- Reported favorably. Rules suspended. Read by title; ordered engrossed and passed to third reading and final passage.
- SB115 Connick COMMERCIAL REGULATIONS
Provides relative to advertisements for legal services. (gov sig)
- Senate floor amendments read and adopted. Read by title and passed by a vote of 34 yeas and 0 nays; ordered reengrossed and sent to the House. Motion to reconsider tabled.
- SB145 Mills, Robert COURTS
Provides relative to fees charged by the clerk of court for the Twenty-sixth Judicial District Court. (2/3 - CA7s2.1(A)) (8/1/20)

- SB156 Luneau INSURERS
Prohibits insurance contracts from depriving courts of this state of the jurisdiction or venue of action against insurer. (8/1/20)

- SB164 Allain TAX/LOCAL
Provides relative to local sales and use tax adjudication. (7/1/20)

- SB180 Morris, Jay FEES/LICENSES/PERMITS

Authorizes clerks of court to have law enforcement officers at polling places on election day to enforce law and authorizes law enforcement officers to enter voting location in an emergency. (gov sig)

- SB186 Harris, Jimmy COURTS
Provides relative to the Municipal and Traffic Court of New Orleans. (gov sig)
- Senate floor amendments read and adopted. Read by title and passed by a vote of 33 yeas and 0 nays; ordered reengrossed and sent to the House. Motion to reconsider tabled.
- SB188 White, B CRIME/PUNISHMENT
Designates the crime of possession of a firearm by a felon as a "crime of violence". (gov sig)

SB231 Talbot INSURANCE POLICIES
Provides with respect to the Louisiana Health Plan. (gov sig)

SB270 Fields COURTS
Provides that jurors be paid an amount equal to the amount that jurors in federal cases receive. (1/1/21)

SB271 Johns HEALTH/ACC INSURANCE
Provides relative to the Health Care Consumer Billing and Disclosure Protection Act. (8/1/20)

SB272 Abraham TAX EXEMPTIONS
Constitutional amendment to establish an ad valorem tax exemption for property subject to a cooperative endeavor agreement requiring the property owner to make payments in lieu of taxes. (2/3 - CA13s1(A))

SB283 Allain TAX/LOCAL
Provides relative to local sales tax administration. (1/1/21)

- SB426 Barrow INSURANCE CLAIMS
Requires health insurance coverage for COVID-19 (Coronavirus) diagnostic testing. (gov sig)
- Senate floor amendments read and adopted. Read by title and passed by a vote of 34 yeas and 0 nays; ordered reengrossed and sent to the House. Motion to reconsider tabled.
- SB433 Mizell CRIMINAL PROCEDURE
Provides that a mandatory reporter of child abuse has cause to suspect abuse if a child under the age of thirteen is pregnant. (gov sig)
