- SB180 Morris, Jay FEES/LICENSES/PERMITS  
 Provides qualifications and licensing requirements for title insurance producers. (8/1/20)  
 - Senate floor amendments read and adopted. Read by title and passed by a vote of 31 yeas and 0 nays; ordered reengrossed and sent to the House. Motion to reconsider tabled.
- SB183 Harris, Jimmy ELECTION DAYS  
 Authorizes clerks of court to have law enforcement officers at polling places on election day to enforce law and authorizes law enforcement officers to enter voting location in an emergency. (gov sig)  
 - Read by title, passed by a vote of 32 yeas and 0 nays, and sent to the House. Motion to reconsider tabled.
- SB271 Johns HEALTH/ACC INSURANCE  
 Provides relative to the Health Care Consumer Billing and Disclosure Protection Act. (8/1/20)  
 - Senate floor amendments read and adopted. Read by title and passed by a vote of 32 yeas and 0 nays; ordered reengrossed and sent to the House. Motion to reconsider tabled.
- SB365 Cloud STUDENTS  
 Requires that information be provided to students about high demand jobs during the development and revision of their individual graduation plans. (gov sig)  
 - Senate floor amendments read and adopted; read by title and returned to its regular order on third reading and final passage.
- SB373 Cloud INSURERS  
 Revises time period in which insurer must provide an insured loss claims history upon request. (8/1/20)  
 - Read by title, passed by a vote of 31 yeas and 0 nays, and sent to the House. Motion to reconsider tabled.
- SB440 Fesi COASTAL RESOURCES  
 Provides for enforcement of the Coastal Zone Management Program. (8/1/20)  
 - Rules suspended. Reported with amendments. Rules suspended. Read by title; Committee amendments read and adopted. Ordered engrossed and passed to third reading and final passage.
- SB443 Ward ADVERTISING  
 Prohibits certain advertising costs from being passed on to clients or customers. (8/1/20)  
 - Read by title and returned to the Calendar, subject to call.
- SB517 Fields WORKERS' COMPENSATION  
 Provides for continuation of the weekly death benefit for the surviving spouse of a law enforcement officer upon remarriage. (8/1/20)  
 - Senate floor amendments read and adopted. Read by title and passed by a vote of 32 yeas and 0 nays; ordered reengrossed and sent to the House. Motion to reconsider tabled.
- SCR22 Barrow BESE  
 Requests BESE to suspend statewide standardized assessments for the 2019-2020 school year due to COVID-19.  
 - Read by title and adopted by a vote of 32 yeas and 0 nays. Ordered sent to the House.
- SCR53 Allain CONDOLENCES  
 Expresses condolences on the death of former Louisiana House of Representatives and Senate member, the Honorable Dudley Anthony "Butch" Gautreaux Jr.  
 - Enrolled. Signed by the President of the Senate.
