Provides for the regulation of certain advertisements for legal services. (8/1/21)

Requires certain absentee ballots to be delivered to an employee of the registrar of voters. (gov sig)

Provides relative to mandatory drug testing, screening, and assessment for drug and specialty court participation for certain offenders. (See Act)

- SB156 Mizell AMUSEMENTS/SPORTS  
Provides for the Fairness in Women's Sports Act relative to a school's ability to offer opportunities to each student to participate in team sporting events on an equal basis. (8/1/21)

Provides relative to the legislative auditor examinations, audits, and reviews of elections and retention of election records. (See Act)
