HB1	Zeringue	APPROPRIATIONS	Provides for the ordinary operating expenses of state government for Fiscal Year 2023-2024 - Veto message received and read. Lies over under the rules.
HB2	Bishop	CAPITAL OUTLAY	Provides for the comprehensive Capital Outlay budget - Veto message received and read. Lies over under the rules.
HB81	Crews	EDUCATION	Provides relative to the use of certain names and pronouns for students - Veto message received and read. Lies over under the rules. - Rules suspended. - Reconsidered. - Veto message read, roll called on final consideration. 67 yeas, 29 nays. Not having received two-thirds vote of the elected members, the veto was not overridden.
HB85	Johnson, Mike	CRIME/MISDEMEANOR	Creates the crime of approaching a law enforcement officer lawfully engaged in law enforcement duties - Veto message received and read. Lies over under the rules.
HB91	Goudeau	CRIME/HOMICIDE	Provides relative to vehicular homicide - Veto message received and read. Lies over under the rules.
HB125	Echols	AGRICULTURE	Provides relative to agriculture land protection against foreign adversaries - Veto message received and read. Lies over under the rules. - Rules suspended. - Reconsidered. - Veto message read, roll called on final consideration, 72 yeas, 25 nays. Veto overridden by two-thirds vote of the elected members. - Notice Senate failed to override the veto.
HB166	Bacala	BUDGETARY CONTROLS	Requires certain information and analysis to be included in the governor's executive budget and the General Appropriation Bill - Veto message received and read. Lies over under the rules. - Rules suspended. - Reconsidered. - Veto message read, roll called on final consideration. 69 yeas, 29 nays. Not having received two-thirds vote of the elected members, the veto was not overridden.
HB182	Edmonston	VACCINES/VACCINATION	Provides that no person shall be required to receive a COVID-19 vaccine as a condition of enrollment or attendance at any public or nonpublic school - Veto message received and read. Lies over under the rules. - Rules suspended. - Reconsidered.

Provides relative to denial of parole for dangerous offenders

 - Veto message read, roll called in final consideration. 67 yeas, 29 nays. Not having received two-thirds vote of the elected members, the veto was not overridden.
- HB205 Bryant SCHOOLS/EMPLOYEES
Requires additional compensation for teachers and other school employees under certain circumstances

 - Veto message received and read. Lies over under the rules.
- HB260 Beaulieu ELECTIONS
Provides relative to federal election guidance and funding

 - Veto message received and read. Lies over under the rules.
- HB309 Garofalo INSURANCE
Provides relative to fortified home and commercial standards

 - Veto message received and read. Lies over under the rules.
 - Rules suspended.
 - Reconsidered.
 - Veto message read, roll called on final consideration. 66 yeas, 29 nays. Not having received two-thirds vote of the elected members, the veto was not overridden.
- HB399 Edmonston VACCINES/VACCINATION
Requires that communication issued about immunization requirements include exemption information and applies exemptions not only to students seeking to enter school but also to students attending school

 - Veto message received and read. Lies over under the rules.
 - Rules suspended.
 - Reconsidered.
 - Veto message read, roll called on final consideration, 70 yeas, 27 nays. Veto overridden by two-thirds vote of the elected members.
 - Notice Senate failed to override the veto.
- HB415 Amedee BANKS/BANKING
Provides relative to central bank digital currency

 - Veto message received and read. Lies over under the rules.
 - Rules suspended.
 - Reconsidered.
 - Veto message read, roll called on final consideration. 69 yeas, 29 nays. Not having received two-thirds vote of the elected members, the veto was not overridden.
- HB466 Horton CURRICULA
Provides relative to discussion of sexual orientation and gender identity in public schools

 - Veto message received and read. Lies over under the rules.

HB648 Firment HEALTH/CHILDREN
Prohibits certain procedures to alter the sex of a minor child

- Rules suspended, called out of its regular order.
- Reconsidered.
- Veto message read, roll called on final consideration, 75 yeas, 23 nays. Veto overridden by two-thirds vote of the elected members.
- Notice Senate voted to override the Governor's veto

HB658 Crews HEALTH CARE/FACILITIES
Provides relative to disclosure by healthcare facilities to patients of prices for certain items and services

- Veto message received and read. Lies over under the rules.
- Rules suspended.

- Veto message read, roll called on final consideration. 69 yeas, 29 nays. Not having received two-thirds vote of the elected members, the veto was no overridden.

HB659 Romero CRIME/BATTERY
Creates a statewide database for individuals convicted of certain offenses against minors
