	Dedicates an additional 1% of the state sales tax on hotel-motel rooms collected in Iberia Parish to the Iberia Parish Tourist Commission. (Both SGF revs decr & Other revs incr by an avg \$42,150 in FYs 00-01 thru 04-05. See fiscal note.)

attendance fee amounts within specified limits, applies certain Bd. of Regents policy guidelines to administrative salary increases, and authorizes converting LSU-A to an institution

HB 11 COURTS/COURT COSTS POWELL SI GOV 07/05 16  
Permits the City Court of Hammond to transfer surplus filing fees

HB 12 WILDLIFE/FEES DANIEL SI GOV 06/26 1  
Provides relative to license fees for hunting and fishing (Other revs incr an avg \$8.7 mill in FYs 00-01 thru 04-05 & Fed revs incr an avg \$264,601 in FYs 01-02 thru 04-05 & Other expd incr in FYs 00-01 thru 04-05. See fiscal note.)

HB 15 TAX/SALES-USE, LOCAL TOWNSEND SI GOV 07/05 17  
Authorizes the Natchitoches Parish governing authority to levy an additional sales tax (Local expd/revs incr \$4 million in FYs 00-01 thru 04-05. See fiscal note.)

HB 17 GAMBLING/VIDEO POKER MARTINY BL GOV 07/16 26  
Provides for criteria for certain multiple licensed facilities owned by single owner within a single building or structure

HB 18 RETIREMENT/TEACHERS CRANE SI GOV 07/05 18  
Removes the waiting period and lessens the earnings limit applicable upon reemployment of certain retired employees of colleges and universities who have attained at least age 62 (SGF exp inc avg \$664k & Locals inc avg \$298k all in FYs 01-05.)

HB 21 WILDLIFE/FEES ODINET SI GOV 07/05 19  
Authorizes a one-time crab trap gear fee increase (Other revs incr \$196,000 in FY 00-01, \$111,000 in 01-02 & \$68,000 in 02-03 thru 04-05. See fiscal note.)

HB 23 DISTRICTS/NEIGHBORHOOD SCHWEGMANN SI GOV 07/05 20  
Creates the Lake Oaks Subdivision Improvement District (Local expd incr & revs in \$90,000 in FYs 00-01 thru 04-05. See fiscal note.)

HB 24 FUNDS/FUNDING ALARIO SI GOV 06/28 5  
Removes for one year the requirement for repayment of interfund borrowing by August 15 (Item No. 9)

HB 25 TAX/INCOME TAX McMANS SI GOV 07/05 21  
Requires composite individual income tax returns and payments by certain non-corporate entities (Item No. 6) (SGF revs incr in FYs 01-02 thru 04-05. See fiscal note.)

HB 26 RETIREMENT/JUDGES PRATT SI GOV 07/11 25  
Changes the date by which certain judges must have been serving in a court of record to be eligible for early judicial retirement benefits (SGF expd incr an avg \$8,656 in FYs 01-02 thru 04-05. See Actuarial note.)

HB 27 TAX/SALES & USE JOHNS SI GOV 07/05 22  
Extends the tax refund for sales and use taxes paid on the sale, lease, or rental of tangible personal property paid by or under provisions of Medicare to include local taxes (Local revs decrease in FYs 00-01 thru 04-05. See fiscal note.)
