

- SB 1 C ROMERO ASSESSORS  
Provides relative to the clerical and expense allowance for the Iberia Parish Tax Assessor's Office. (Local expd/revs incr \$700,000 in FY 00-01 & \$170,750 in FYs 01-02 thru 04-05. See fiscal note.)  
Read by title and finally passed, 34 yeas and 1 nays. Title read and adopted and bill ordered to the House. Motion to reconsider tabled.
- SB 2 C ROMERO TAX/TAXATION  
Dedicates an additional 1% of the state sales tax on hotel-motel rooms collected in Iberia Parish to the Iberia Parish Tourist Commission. (Both SGF revs decr & Other revs incr by an avg \$42,150 in FYs 00-01 thru 04-05. See fiscal note.)  
Read by title and finally passed as amended 35 yeas and 1 nays. Title read and adopted, bill ordered to the House. Motion to reconsider tabled.
- SB 3 C ROMERO MUNICIPALITIES  
Provides relative to the applicability of certain civil service provisions and the procedure by which the position of police chief is filled in New Iberia. (2/3-CA10s18)  
Read by title and failed to pass 18 yeas, and 11 nays. Motion to reconsider tabled.
- SB 4 JOHNSON TAX/TAXATION  
Constitutional amendment to require a two-thirds vote to enact exemptions or exclusions from local sales and use taxes. (2/3-CA13s1(A)) (See fiscal note.)  
Read by title and failed to pass, 25 yeas and 9 nays. Notice of reconsideration.
- SB 5 CRAVINS COURTS  
Requires a fee for subpoena services by the Opelousas City Marshal. (Local expd/revs incr \$7,800 in FYs 00-01 thru 04-05. See fiscal note.)  
Read by title and finally passed, 30 yeas and 1 nays. Title read and adopted and bill ordered to the House. Motion to reconsider tabled.
- SB 6 THOMAS COLLEGES/UNIVERSITIES  
Corrects the name of Our Lady of the Lake College and adds St. Joseph Seminary College to the list of eligible independent institutions for certain reimbursements. (gov sig)  
Read by title and finally passed, 33 yeas and 0 nays. Title read and adopted and bill ordered to the House. Motion to reconsider tabled.
- SB 7 HAINKEL FIRE PROTECTION  
Increases per diem for governing board members of a fire protection district with a population of more than 100,000 persons. (Local expd incr in FYs 00-01 thru 04-05. See fiscal note.)  
Read by title and finally passed, 30 yeas and 3 nays. Title read and adopted and bill ordered to the House. Motion to reconsider tabled.
- SCR 2 HAINKEL CONDOLENCES  
Expresses condolences upon the death of John Bean, son of Senator Ron Bean.  
Received from the House without amendments.
- SCR 3 DARDENNE CONGRESS  
Memorializes Congress to support and to adopt the Physical Education for Progress (PEP) bill.  
Received from the House without amendments.
- SCR 4 MARIONNEAUX CONDOLENCES  
Expresses condolences upon the death of volunteer firefighter Michael "Scotty" Brown.  
Received from the House without amendments.
- SCR 5 M SMITH TRANSPORTATION/DEV DEPT  
Requests DOTD to donate used asphalt to local governments to the maximum extent authorized by law.  
Received from the House without amendments.
- SCR 6 SCHEDLER HEALTH/HOSPITALS DEPT  
Requests DHH to promulgate rules to encourage voluntary placement of nursing home beds in abeyance to reduce the total number of Medicaid-certified beds in the state and provide greater efficiency in operation of nursing homes and Medicaid.

Received from the House without amendments.

- SCR 8 FONTENOT PUBLIC SFTY/CORRECT DEPT  
Requests the office of state fire marshal to continue to maintain the state administrative agent function on behalf of HUD.  
Rules suspended, recalled from committee.  
Read by title, amended, adopted by the vote of 33 yeas and 0 nays. Ordered engrossed and sent to the House.
- SCR 9 DARDENNE COMMENDATIONS  
Commends the LSU baseball team on winning its fifth national title at the 2000 NCAA College World Series.  
Introduced in the Senate. Read by title, rules suspended, adopted by the vote of 37 yeas and 0 nays and ordered to the House.  
Received from the House without amendments.
- SCR 10 C ROMERO COMMENDATIONS  
Commends the University of Louisiana at Lafayette Ragin' Cajuns baseball team on its outstanding season and showing at the College World Series.

- HB 1 LEBLANC APPROPRIATIONS  
Provides for the ordinary expenses of state government  
Received in the Senate. Rules suspended read first and second time by title and referred to the committee on FINANCE.
- HB 2 LEBLANC APPROPRIATIONS/ANCILLARY  
Provides for the ancillary expenses of state government  
Received in the Senate. Rules suspended read first and second time by title and referred to the committee on FINANCE.
- HB 3 LEBLANC APPROPRIATIONS  
Appropriates funds for the expenses of the judiciary  
Received in the Senate. Rules suspended read first and second time by title and referred to the committee on FINANCE.
- HB 5 DEWITT LOCAL OFFL/POLICE CHIEFS  
Authorizes the governing authority of the village of McNary to abolish the office of police chief or provide for filling the office by appointment and provides for obtaining law enforcement services  
Received in the Senate. Rules suspended read first and second time by title and referred to the committee on LOCAL & MUN AFFAIRS.
- HB 7 DIEZ TRANSPORTATION DEPT  
Provides for the qualifications of the assistant secretary for the office of planning and programming (No anticipated direct fiscal impact. See fiscal note.)  
Received in the Senate. Rules suspended read first and

second time by title and referred to the committee on  
TRAN, HWY & PUBL WKS.

- HB 8 DIEZ FUNDS/FUNDING  
Provides for the deposit and credit of certain fees and taxes to the state general fund  
Received in the Senate. Rules suspended read first and second time by title and referred to the committee on FINANCE.
- HB 11 POWELL COURTS/COURT COSTS  
Permits the City Court of Hammond to transfer surplus filing fees  
Received in the Senate. Rules suspended read first and second time by title and referred to the committee on JUDICIARY A.
- HB 15 TOWNSEND TAX/SALES-USE, LOCAL  
Authorizes the Natchitoches Parish governing authority to levy an additional sales tax (Local expd/revs incr \$4 million in FYs 00-01 thru 04-05. See fiscal note.)  
Received in the Senate. Rules suspended read first and second time by title and referred to the committee on LOCAL & MUN AFFAIRS.
- HB 18 CRANE RETIREMENT/TEACHERS  
Removes the waiting period and lessens the earnings limit applicable upon reemployment of certain retired employees of colleges and universities who have attained at least age 62 (SGF exp inc avg \$664k & Locals inc avg \$298k all in FYs 01-05.)  
Received in the Senate. Rules suspended read first and second time by title and referred to the committee on RETIREMENT.
- HB 22 FAUCHEUX COURTS  
Provides for additional fees for the clerk of court of St. John the Baptist Parish (Local expd/revs incr \$158,900 in FYs 00-01 thru 04-05. See fiscal note.)  
Received in the Senate. Rules suspended read first and second time by title and referred to the committee on JUDICIARY A.
- HB 23 SCHWEGMANN DISTRICTS/NEIGHBORHOOD  
Creates the Lake Oaks Subdivision Improvement District (Local expd incr & revs in \$90,000 in FYs 00-01 thru 04-05. See fiscal note.)  
Received in the Senate. Rules suspended read first and second time by title and referred to the committee on LOCAL & MUN AFFAIRS.
- HB 24 ALARIO FUNDS/FUNDING  
Removes for one year the requirement for repayment of interfund borrowing by August 15 (Item No. 9)  
Received in the Senate. Rules suspended read first and second time by title and referred to the committee on FINANCE.
- HB 25 McMANS TAX/INCOME TAX  
Requires composite individual income tax returns and payments by certain non-corporate entities (Item No. 6) (SGF revs incr in FYs 01-02 thru 04-05. See fiscal note.)  
Received in the Senate. Rules suspended read first and second time by title and referred to the committee on REV & FISCAL AFFAIRS.
- HB 26 PRATT RETIREMENT/JUDGES  
Changes the date by which certain judges must have been serving in a court of record to be eligible for early judicial retirement benefits (SGF expd incr an avg \$8,656 in FYs 01-02 thru 04-05. See Actuarial note.)  
Received in the Senate. Rules suspended read first and second time by title and referred to the committee on RETIREMENT.
- HB 27 JOHNS TAX/SALES & USE  
Extends the tax refund for sales and use taxes paid on the sale, lease, or rental of tangible personal property paid by or under provisions of Medicare to include local taxes (Local revs decrease in FYs 00-01 thru 04-05. See fiscal note.)  
Received in the Senate. Rules suspended read first and second time by title and referred to the committee on REV & FISCAL AFFAIRS.
- HB 28 LEBLANC APPROPRIATIONS  
Provides for the ordinary operating expenses of the state for

the 1999-2000 Fiscal Year (Item No. 1)

Received in the Senate. Rules suspended read first and second time by title and referred to the committee on FINANCE.

- HB 30 STELLY FUNDS/FUNDING  
Relative to the Educational Enhancement Fund, provides relative to pay increases for certain elementary, secondary, and higher education personnel  
Received in the Senate. Rules suspended read first and second time by title and referred to the committee on FINANCE.
- HB 31 ALARIO TAX/SALES-USE, ST-EXEMPT  
Makes suspension of exemptions to one percent of the state sales and use tax ineffective on June 30, 2001 (See fiscal note)  
Received in the Senate. Rules suspended read first and second time by title and referred to the committee on REV & FISCAL AFFAIRS.
- HCR 2 DANIEL COMMENDATIONS  
Commends Louisiana's Old State Capitol for student fund raising efforts on behalf of the National World War II Memorial and encourages statewide support of the memorial project

- HCR 3 CLARKSON INSURANCE  
Urges and requests the Louisiana congressional delegation to support federal legislation relative to health insurance and genetic testing

Read by title and concurred in by the vote of 31 yeas and 0 nays and ordered to the House.
- HCR 8 KENNARD COMMENDATIONS  
Commends and congratulates the 2000 LSU Baseball Tigers on winning their fifth National Championship in ten years  
Received in the Senate. Rules suspended, read by title and concurred in by the vote of 37 yeas and 0 nays and ordered to the House.
- HCR 9 KENNARD COMMENDATIONS  
Commends and congratulates the LSU women's track and field team for winning the 2000 National Collegiate Athletic Association Outdoor Track and Field Championship
