

- HB 2 DEWITT GAMBLING/RIVERBOAT  
Provides for gaming while riverboats are docked and gaming on permanently moored riverboat vessels  
Read third time by title, amended, roll called on final passage, yeas 82, nays 20. The bill, having received two-thirds vote of the members elect, was finally passed, title adopted, ordered to the Senate.
- HB 4 MARTINY GAMBLING/RIVERBOAT  
Provides for gaming while riverboats are docked and gaming on permanently moored riverboat vessels  
Read by title, amended, returned to the calendar subject to call.
- HB 5 RIDDLE UNEMPLOYMENT COMP
