

- SB 1 HOLLIS GAMING
Revises minimum compensation payments and other restrictions applicable to the land-based casino and certain gaming revenue dedications. (gov sig)
Introduced in the Senate, rules suspended, read first and second time by title and referred to the committee on JUDICIARY B.
- SB 2 MCPHERSON PUBLIC LANDS
Transfers property of the Esler Industrial Development District to the state military for use by the Louisiana National Guard. (04-01-01)
Introduced in the Senate, rules suspended, read first and second time by title and referred to the committee on LOCAL & MUN AFFAIRS.
- SB 3 BOISSIERE GAMING
Revises minimum compensation payments and other restrictions applicable to the land-based casino and certain gaming revenue dedications. (gov sig)
Introduced in the Senate, rules suspended, read first and second time by title and referred to the committee on JUDICIARY B.
- SR 1 LAMBERT LEGISLATIVE SESSIONS

Rules suspended; introduced in the Senate. Read by title, rules suspended, adopted.
- SCR 1 LAMBERT LEGISLATIVE SESSIONS
Invites the governor to address a joint session of the legislature on Sunday, March 11, 2001 at 6:30 p.m.
Rules suspended; introduced in the Senate. Read by title.
Rules suspended; adopted by the vote of 30 yeas and 0 nays and ordered to the House.
Received from the House without amendments.
- SCR 2 HINES CONDOLENCES
Expresses condolences on the death of Mervin Lee Trail, MD.
Introduced in the Senate, read first time by title.
- HCR 1 CRANE SPECIAL DAY/WEEK/MONTH
Commends the Great American Cleanup Project, proclaims April of 2001 as Keep America Beautiful Month, and designates April 7, 2001, as Great American Cleanup Day
Received in the Senate. Read by title.
