

- SB 1 HOLLIS GAMING
Revises minimum compensation payments and other restrictions applicable to the land-based casino and certain gaming revenue dedications. (gov sig)
Rules suspended, reported with amendments. Rules suspended, read by title, committee amendments read and adopted.
Ordered reengrossed and passed to a third reading.
Rules suspended.
Read by title and finally passed as amended 23 yeas and 15 nays. Title read and adopted, bill ordered to the House.
Motion to reconsider tabled.
- SB 2 MCPHERSON PUBLIC LANDS
Transfers property of the Esler Industrial Development District to the state military for use by the Louisiana National Guard. (04-01-01)
Rules suspended.
Read by title and finally passed as amended 37 yeas and 0 nays. Title read and adopted, bill ordered to the House.
Motion to reconsider tabled.
- SCR 3 HAINKEL CONDOLENCES
Expresses the condolences of the members of the Legislature and the members of its staff to the family of Jean Harkins Russell.
Rules suspended; introduced in the Senate. Read by title.
Rules suspended; adopted by the vote of 38 yeas and 0 nays and ordered to the House.

- HB 2 DEWITT GAMBLING/RIVERBOAT
Provides for gaming while riverboats are docked and gaming on permanently moored riverboat vessels
Received in the Senate. Rules suspended read first and second time by title and referred to the committee on JUDICIARY B.
- HB 5 RIDDLE UNEMPLOYMENT COMP
Permits Indian tribes to reimburse benefits for the purposes of unemployment compensation benefits
