- HCR 5 SALTER HIGHWAYS
Memorializes Congress to sponsor a special highway appropriation amendment to four-lane U.S. Highway 84 from I-49 near Mansfield, Louisiana to Tenaha, Texas
Committee amendments read and adopted.
Read by title. Amended, concurred in by the vote of 33 yeas and 0 nays and ordered to the House.
- HCR 7 CROWE ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT
Urges and requests all state agencies and departments to procure goods and services from Louisiana-based businesses
Read by title and concurred in by the vote of 34 yeas and 0 nays and ordered to the House.

- HCR 8 FARRAR SPECIAL DAY/WEEK/MONTH
Recognizes December 2, 2001, as a day of honor for the Second World War soldiers and citizens of Louisiana
