

- SB 26 B JONES JUDGES  
Provides for an additional judge for the Third Judicial District Court. (gov sig) (2/3-CA5s15(D))  
Reported with amendments.
- SB 41 LENTINI SEX OFFENSES  
Adds requirement that sex offenders register with police chiefs of incorporated areas.  
Reported favorably.
- SB 70 C FIELDS CHILDREN  
Requires visitation for non-custodial parent whenever that parent is ordered to pay child support, unless contrary to best interest of child.  
Reported favorably.
- SB 80 C FIELDS CRIME/PUNISHMENT  
Creates a study commission to study capital punishment in the state.  
Reported with amendments.
- SB 132 LAMBERT JUDGES  
Provides relative to the salary of the judge of the Ascension Parish Court. (gov sig)  
Reported favorably.
- SB 155 LAMBERT DISTRICT ATTORNEYS  
Provides for additional assistant district attorneys and for their salaries in the Twenty-Third Judicial District. (gov sig)  
Reported favorably.
- SB 254 B JONES TRUSTS  
Provides for who may be a trustee of a trust.  
Reported favorably.
- SB 281 LENTINI COURTS  
Provides for an increase in certain fees of the 24th Judicial District Court. (gov sig)  
Reported favorably.
- SB 299 SCHEDLER HEALTH CARE  
Provides that criminal history checks on certain nonlicensed persons and ambulance personnel are valid for twelve months.  
Rules suspended, recalled from committee.  
Withdrawn from the files of the Senate.
- SB 364 ELLINGTON CLERKS OF COURT  
Increases certain fees which are paid to the clerks of court and deletes provisions requiring the payment of certain other fees.  
Reported with amendments.
- SB 365 ELLINGTON CLERKS OF COURT  
Provides for the fees charged by clerks of court for recording multiple indebtedness mortgages and for the form of those mortgages.  
Reported favorably.
- SB 804 HOLLIS HEALTH CARE  
Establishes the Louisiana Fair Prescription Drug Pricing Act.  
Rules suspended, recalled from committee.  
Withdrawn from the files of the Senate.
- SB 981 C D JONES PUBLIC UTILITIES  
Requires utility companies serving Ouachita Parish Correctional Facility to include their gross receipts before any computation of franchise fees owed the town of Richwood.  
Introduced in the Senate, rules suspended, read first and second time by title and referred to the committee on JUDICIARY A.

SB 982 HEITMEIER UTILITIES  
Provides for the enforcement of the Louisiana Underground Utilities and Facilities Damage Prevention Law.
