

- SB 4 HINES LEGISLATIVE SESSIONS  
Constitutional amendment to provide for consideration of certain matters during regular sessions in even-numbered years. (2/3-CA13s1(A))  
Rules suspended.  
Made special order of the day No. 1 for 4/18.
- SB 82 C FIELDS PARDON/PAROLE  
Constitutional amendment to require that favorable recommendations by the Board of Pardons take effect sixty days after receipt unless denied by the governor.  
Reconsidered. Read by title and returned to the calendar subject to call.
- SB 104 ULLO CRIME/PUNISHMENT  
Provides a criminal penalty for executing a false statement regarding the need to take another person into protective custody.  
Read by title, engrossed and passed to a third reading.
- SB 105 ULLO CORONERS  
Provides relative to fixing fees and expenses for medical examinations prior to commitment.  
Read by title, engrossed and passed to a third reading.
- SB 111 ULLO FUNDS/FUNDING  
Provides relative to the coroner's operational fund.  
Read by title, committee amendments read and adopted.  
Ordered engrossed and passed to a third reading.
- SB 148 ULLO CORONERS  
Authorizes physician coroner to pronounce death based on certain information received.

- SB 211 IRONS INSURERS  
Requires health insurers to cover certain medically prescribed contraceptives and contraceptive services. (10/1/01)  
Read by title, committee amendments read and adopted.

- SB 221 HINES ETHICS  
Provides for an exception from the Ethics Code to allow former city/parish school board members to contract with, be employed by, or be appointed by such board to any school building level position with such board which requires a teacher's certificate.

Ordered engrossed and passed to a third reading.
- SB 225 M SMITH GAMING  
Constitutional amendment to prohibit any referendum elections in a certain parish to allow or expand gaming by legislative act. (2/3-CA13s1(A))

- SB 241 CAMPBELL POLITICAL CAMPAIGNS  
Constitutional amendment to prohibit the secretary of state and the commissioner of elections from engaging in certain political activities. (2/3-CA13s1(A))

- SB 249 DUPRE EXPROPRIATION  
Authorizes the Terrebonne Parish Consolidated Government to expropriate by a declaration of taking.

Authorizes the Colsolidation Terrebonne Parish Waterworks

District No. 1 to expropriate by a declaration of taking.

Authorizes filings of pleadings and documents to clerks of court offices by facsimile transmission in criminal cases as permitted by the policy of each clerk of court.

- SB 300 CHAISSON LOCAL OFFICIALS  
Requires a minimum salary paid by the parish governing authority for certain justices of the peace and constables.

- SB 306 C FIELDS CRIMINAL PROCEDURE  
Provides for DNA testing at the request of persons confined, paroled, or otherwise released due to conviction or pleading guilty to certain offenses and requires that district attorneys release evidence for such testing.

- SB 336 MICHOT JUDGES  
Provides for salary of commissioners at 90% of district judge's salary. (gov sig)

Creates the crime of cyberstalking.

- SR 4 SCHEDLER COMMITTEE STUDIES  
Creates the Louisiana Child Visitation Center Review Commission  
to study establishing child visitation centers in the state to  
provide safe, supervised settings for noncustodial parents to  
visit with their children.  
Read by title, adopted.
- SR 9 BOISSIERE COMMENDATIONS  
Commends Edgar F. Poree, Jr. for a lifetime of dedicated,  
extraordinary, and exemplary service and contribution to his

state and community, on the occasion of his retirement.

Enrolled, signed by the President of the Senate and sent to the Secretary of State.

- SCR 9 THEUNISSEN CONGRESS  
Memorializes Congress to take necessary and appropriate action to reduce insurance rates for active duty military personnel.  
Read by title, adopted by the vote of 34 yeas and 0 nays and ordered to the House.
- SCR 12 HINES PUBLIC BUILDINGS/GROUNDS  
Requests necessary steps be taken to name the clinical sciences research building, located at LSU Health Sciences Center at New Orleans, the Dr. Mervin L. Trail Clinical Sciences Research Building.  
Read by title. Returned to the calendar subject to call.
- SCR 19 SCHEDLER COMMITTEE STUDIES  
Creates the Louisiana Child Visitation Center Review Commission to study establishing child visitation centers in the state to provide safe, supervised settings for noncustodial parents to visit with their children.  
Read by title, adopted by the vote of 35 yeas and 0 nays and ordered to the House.
- SCR 31 C FIELDS PUBLIC SFTY/CORRECT DEPT  
Requests dept. to study the availability of programs and resources for inmate development and make a comparison among institutions.

- SCR 40 CAMPBELL CRIME/PUNISHMENT  
Requests the Louisiana Forestry Commission to change the color of paint used to post private property from grey to purple.

Commends Leesville High School Boys Basketball Team on winning the Class 4A State Championship.

Establishes a special committee to study the feasibility of developing work release programs within the confines of correctional facilities.

Authorizes the perpetual existence of co-operative marketing associations

HB 1634 BRUCE CRIME  
Provides for the collection of court costs on nonmoving traffic violations in parishes included in the Louisiana Criminalistics Laboratory

HB 1767 HOPKINS HEALTH/DHH
