Establishes the process for legislative approval of plans for expending money from the Educational Excellence Funds. (gov sig)
Reported with amendments.
- SB 24 MCPHERSON MOTOR VEHICLES
Requires motor vehicles to be removed from any roadway after being involved in an accident.
Reported favorably.
- SB 25 HINES HEALTH CARE
Authorizes physician assistants-certified to prescribe and administer certain drugs and medical devices under certain conditions and to provide for the duties and meetings of the physician assistants advisory committee. (7/1/01)
Read by title and finally passed as amended 32 yeas and 1 nays. Title read and adopted, bill ordered to the House.
Motion to reconsider tabled.
- SB 28 LENTINI ROADS/HIGHWAYS
Requires compliance with night work provisions on highway projects where DOTD has found night work feasible in order to qualify for contract incentives to construct expeditiously.

- SB 52 THEUNISSEN TEACHERS
Provides a formula for the calculation of savings resulting from the elimination of Gayle pay and the revision of sabbatical leave provisions. (gov sig)

- SB 57 HAINKEL SCHOOLS
Revises requirements regarding admission of "at-risk" students into a charter school established with the mission to meet the needs of the children of military personnel. (gov sig)

- SB 112 C ROMERO NATURAL RESOURCES DEPT
Clarifies the powers and duties of the commissioner of conservation. (7/1/01)
Reported with amendments.
- SB 115 THEUNISSEN SCHOOLS
Requires all schools to have a written crisis management and response plan in place by 1/1/02. (gov sig)
Reported with amendments.
- SB 118 THEUNISSEN STUDENTS
Requires the transfer of student education records within 10 working days of a written request by an educational facility and removes authority to withhold a student's grades under certain circumstances. (gov sig)

Constitutional amendment to permit certain political activity by members of the municipal fire and police civil service system. (2/3-CAL3s1(A))

Provides relative to the preservation of cajun and creole culture by management of natural resources.

- SB 334 CRAVINS MOTOR VEHICLES
Increases the minimum time required to maintain a Class "E" learner's license from 90 days to 180 days.

- SB 349 CHAISSON CRIMINAL PROCEDURE
Adds the crime of negligent injury as a responsive verdict to both vehicular negligent injuring and first degree vehicular negligent injuring.

Prohibits passengers in a motor vehicle from possessing open alcoholic beverage containers and from consuming alcohol beverages.

Provides for an elected chief of police under certain municipal civil service systems. (gov sig)
