Provides relative to disinherison of forced heirs

Creates the U.S. Naval Academy prestige license plate

Authorizes the distribution of profits to owners of an insurance agency

HB 446 G SMITH MTR VEHICLE/LICEN PLATES
Provides for the creation of a prestige license plate featuring the white tail deer
Rules suspended; reported with amendments.

HB 448 J R SMITH MTR VEHICLE/LICEN PLATES
Provides for creation of the Kiwanis International prestige license plate
Rules suspended; reported with amendments.

HB 452 WALSWORTH LOCAL GOVT/ORDINANCES
Provides relative to local authority to regulate parking for certain disabled persons
Reported without Legislative Bureau amendments, read by title and passed to a third reading.

HB 456 ALARIO MUNICIPAL/ORDINANCES
Relative to certain municipalities undertaking the removal of weeds, grass, or other noxious growths, changes notification period to five days
Reported without Legislative Bureau amendments, read by title and passed to a third reading.

HB 458 CRANE SCHOOLS
Increases the minimum number of instructional days per school year in public elementary and secondary schools from 175 to 177
Read by title and referred to the Legislative Bureau.

HB 481 PINAC CONTRACTORS
Allows the Louisiana State Licensing Board for contractors to contract for certain services and initiate civil proceedings against persons fined by the board
Rules suspended; reported favorably.

HB 495 SCHNEIDER RETIREMENT/STATE POLICE
Increases the benefit accrual rate used for the calculation of benefits (to 3.5%)
Read by title. Returned to the calendar subject to call as amended.

HB 496 SCHNEIDER RETIREMENT/STATE POLICE
Authorizes the system to pay annual 2% supplemental COLA to retirees and beneficiaries who are at least age 65
Read by title. Returned to the calendar subject to call.

HB 510 MONTGOMERY RETIREMENT/MUNICIPAL POL
Establishes additional eligibility age for members to enter the DROP plan
Read by title and referred to the Legislative Bureau.

HB 511 MONTGOMERY RETIREMENT/LOCAL
Deletes the general prohibition against the payment of interest and deletes the required one-year waiting period before interest is payable
Signed by the President of the Senate.

HB 533 ANSARDI COURTS/MAYORS
Authorizes the clerk of court to use an electronic signature, stamp, or other such facsimile of the prosecuting attorney's signature to sign the bills of information for the mayor's court in the city of Kenner
Notice House adopted Conference Committee report.

HB 559 DIEZ AIRCRAFT/AIRPORTS
Decreases the state's matching proportion of funding for certain airport projects
Rules suspended; reported with amendments.

HB 568 KENNARD RETIREMENT/DISTRICT ATTY
Authorizes any member of the board of trustees who is an assistant district attorney who retires before the expiration of the term for which he was elected to continue to serve for the remainder of his term

Read by title and finally passed, 35 yeas and 0 nays. Title read and adopted and bill ordered to the House. Motion to reconsider tabled.

- HB 575 NEVERS BOATS/SHIPS/VESSELS
Creates the Louisiana Boat and Motor Titling Act.
Read by title. Returned to the calendar subject to call.
- HB 584 PINAC BUSINESS BROKERS
Makes a technical change to provisions of law that require business opportunity sellers and agent to maintain a surety bond
Rules suspended; reported favorably.
- HB 591 MONTGOMERY RETIREMENT/STATE EMPS
