

- SB 3 DUPRE PORTS/HARBORS/TERMINALS
Provides for the appointment of certain members of the Terrebonne Parish Port Commission.
Reported favorably, rules suspended, read by title, ordered engrossed and passed to a third reading.
- SB 5 CAIN FUNDS/FUNDING
Provides for the allocation and use of monies in the Beauregard Parish Community Development Fund.
Reported with amendments. Rules suspended, read by title, committee amendments read and adopted. Ordered engrossed and passed to a third reading.
- SB 7 DUPRE PUBLIC LANDS
Authorizes the Terrebonne Parish School Board to lease certain property in Terrebonne Parish to the Department of Wildlife and Fisheries.
Reported favorably, rules suspended, read by title, ordered engrossed and passed to a third reading.
- SB 8 HOYT MUNICIPALITIES
Provides for annexation of property by the city of Crowley.
(gov sig)

- SB 9 JOHNSON TAX/TAXATION
Constitutional amendment to require two-thirds vote to enact exemptions or exclusions from local sales and use taxes.
(2/3-CA13s1(A))

- SB 10 HOYT ENVIRONMENTAL HEALTH
Establishes a right-to-know law for medical waste storage.
(gov sig) (2/3-CA7s2.1(A))

- SB 14 THEUNISSEN FUNDS/FUNDING
Reestablishes a dedicated fund to set aside funds for providing rewards to schools earning rewards pursuant to the accountability system. (gov sig)
Reported favorably, rules suspended, read by title, ordered engrossed and passed to a third reading.
- SB 16 THEUNISSEN PORTS/HARBORS/TERMINALS
Provides for per diem for members of the West Calcasieu Port, Harbor, and Terminal District. (gov sig)
Reported with amendments. Rules suspended, read by title, committee amendments read and adopted. Ordered engrossed and passed to a third reading.
- SB 17 THOMAS SPECIAL DISTRICTS
Increases the membership of the board of commissioners of the Washington Parish Hospital Service District Number One.
Reported favorably, rules suspended, read by title, ordered engrossed and passed to a third reading.
- SB 18 DUPRE SPECIAL DISTRICTS
Authorizes the Bayou Lafourche Freshwater District Commission to establish limits relative to per diem and mileage for members.
Reported favorably, rules suspended, read by title, ordered engrossed and passed to a third reading.
- SB 19 HOYT TUITION
Revises START to provide for the payment of earnings enhancement on equities' accounts and to define fully funded as including all qualified educational expenses rather than only tuition. (gov sig)
Reported with amendments. Rules suspended, read by title, committee amendments read and adopted. Ordered engrossed and passed to a third reading.
- SB 20 DARDENNE ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT
Establishes an executive committee of the board of directors for the Research Park Corporation. (gov sig)
Reported with amendments. Rules suspended, read by title, committee amendments read and adopted. Ordered engrossed and passed to a third reading.

- SB 30 HAINKEL MOTOR VEHICLES
Creates the breast cancer awareness special prestige license plate.
Reported favorably, rules suspended, read by title, ordered engrossed and passed to a third reading.
- SB 32 B JONES JUVENILES
Adds a judicial district to the truancy and assessment and service center pilot program.
Reported with amendments. Rules suspended, read by title, committee amendments read and adopted. Ordered engrossed and passed to a third reading.
- SB 33 B JONES EARLY CHILDHOOD ED
Revises program for early childhood development classes for four-year-olds. (gov sig)
Reported favorably. Rules suspended, read by title, ordered engrossed and recommitted to the committee on FINANCE
- SB 34 THEUNISSEN SPECIAL DISTRICTS
Provides for the merger of the Cameron Parish Sewerage District No. 1 and the Cameron Parish Waterworks District No. 1.
Reported with amendments. Rules suspended, read by title, committee amendments read and adopted. Ordered engrossed and passed to a third reading.
- SB 35 THEUNISSEN SCHOOLS
Reinstates provisions providing for the probationary period of a school employee who is promoted in a school system with a population of 425,000 or more. (gov sig)
Reported favorably, rules suspended, read by title, ordered engrossed and passed to a third reading.
- SB 38 MCPHERSON PUBLIC LANDS
Authorizes the Board of Commissioners of the Red River, Atchafalaya, and Bayou Boeuf Levee District to exchange title to certain properties in Rapides Parish with the Hemphill Star Church and Hemphill Star Cemetary.
Reported favorably, rules suspended, read by title, ordered engrossed and passed to a third reading.
- SB 40 BAJOIE SPECIAL DISTRICTS
Relative to the Garden District's Security Special Taxing District, changes name of district and qualifications of board and authorizes renewal of district's special tax/fee.
Reported with amendments. Rules suspended, read by title, committee amendments read and adopted. Ordered engrossed and passed to a third reading.
- SB 42 MCPHERSON PUBLIC LANDS
Provides for the transfer of certain lands in Catahoula Parish from the office of state lands to the Department of Wildlife and Fisheries for inclusion into the Dewey W. Wills Wildlife Management Area.
Reported with amendments. Rules suspended, read by title, committee amendments read and adopted. Ordered engrossed and passed to a third reading.
- SB 45 FONTENOT SPECIAL DISTRICTS
Provides relative to the board of commissioners of Hospital Service District Number One of East Baton Rouge Parish, increases the membership and provides for terms. (gov sig)
Reported with amendments. Rules suspended, read by title, committee amendments read and adopted. Ordered engrossed and passed to a third reading.
- SB 47 BARHAM HOSPITALS
Changes certain criteria for defining rural hospitals. (gov sig)

- SB 48 SCHEDLER SPECIAL DISTRICTS
Provides relative to the East Florida Parishes Retirement District.

Provides relative to the per diem of the members of the board of commissioners of the Calcasieu Cameron Hospital Service District. (gov sig)

- SB 54 M SMITH SPECIAL DISTRICTS
Increases the membership of the board of commissioners of the DeSoto Parish Industrial District and provides for appointment of a treasurer. (gov sig)

- SB 56 HOLLIS COMMERCIAL REGULATIONS
Exempts authorized e-file providers from the definition of loan broker. (gov sig)
Reported with amendments. Rules suspended, read by title, committee amendments read and adopted. Ordered engrossed and passed to a third reading.
- SB 63 BARHAM MUNICIPALITIES
Authorizes the governing authority of the village of Lisbon to provide for an appointed police chief or to abolish the office and obtain law enforcement services. (gov sig)
Reported favorably, rules suspended, read by title, ordered engrossed and passed to a third reading.
- SB 68 SCHEDLER HEALTH CARE
Establishes the Louisiana Health Works Commission.
Reported with amendments. Rules suspended, read by title, committee amendments read and adopted. Ordered engrossed and recommitted to the committee on FINANCE.
- SB 69 SCHEDLER MUNICIPALITIES
Provides for annexation by municipalities. (gov sig)
Reported favorably, rules suspended, read by title, ordered engrossed and passed to a third reading.
- SB 72 HAINKEL SPECIAL DISTRICTS
Provides for the creation of the Audubon Area Security District in Orleans Parish. (gov sig)
Reported favorably, rules suspended, read by title, ordered engrossed and passed to a third reading.
- SB 73 HAINKEL HEALTH CARE
Creates the Tulane/L.S.U. Cancer Research Center.
Reported favorably. Rules suspended, read by title, ordered engrossed and recommitted to the committee on FINANCE
- SB 75 BOISSIERE SPECIAL DISTRICTS
Excludes electricity and gas service from the authority to develop infrastructure on a tax exemption basis through a community development district.
Reported favorably, rules suspended, read by title, ordered engrossed and passed to a third reading.
- SB 80 C D JONES CONTROL DANGER SUBSTANCE
Corrects retroactively the penalty for distribution or possession with intent to distribute marijuana and revises the crime of possession of gamma hydroxybutyric acid (GHB). (gov sig)
Rules suspended; read by title, recommitted to the Committee on JUDICIARY B.
- SB 81 BAJOIE TAX/TAXATION
Dedicates a portion of the revenues from one cent of the state sales tax on hotel occupancy levied in Orleans.
Reported with amendments. Rules suspended, read by title, committee amendments read and adopted. Ordered engrossed and passed to a third reading.
- SB 84 IRONS COURTS
Authorizes the judges of the Civil District Court for the parish of Orleans and the First and Second City Courts of the city of New Orleans to utilize money in the judicial expense fund to construct a new courthouse.
Introduced in the Senate, rules suspended, read first and second time by title and referred to the committee on JUDICIARY A.
- SB 85 DARDENNE TAX/SALES
Excludes certain purchases by a motion picture company from the state sales and use tax. (7/1/02)
Introduced in the Senate, rules suspended, read first and second time by title and referred to the committee on REV & FISCAL AFFAIRS.
- SB 86 DARDENNE TAX/TAXATION
Extends the motion picture investor tax credit to feature films

and television pilots and to "base investments" between \$300,000 and \$2 million. (7/1/02)

- SB 87 DARDENNE TAX/TAXATION
Grants an income and franchise tax credit to motion picture production companies for the employment of residents. (7/1/02)

- SB 88 DARDENNE ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT
Provides for the Technology Commercialization Credit Program. (7/1/02)

Rules suspended; read by title, recommitted to the Committee on REV & FISCAL AFFAIRS.
- SB 89 CAIN CRIME/PUNISHMENT
Creates the crime of operating a motor vehicle without lawful presence in the United States and provides for the issuance and revocation of driver's license to alien students and nonresident aliens.
Introduced in the Senate, rules suspended, read first and second time by title and referred to the committee on JUDICIARY C.
- SB 90 B JONES ROADS/HIGHWAYS
Designates a portion of LA Highway 167 in Jonesboro as the Richard Zuber Thruway.
Introduced in the Senate, rules suspended, read first and second time by title and referred to the committee on TRAN, HWY & PUBL WKS.
- SB 91 DARDENNE TAX/TAXATION
Provides a sales and use tax exemption on capital expenditures for new research equipment purchased by biotechnology start-up companies. (gov sig)
Introduced in the Senate, rules suspended, read first and second time by title and referred to the committee on REV & FISCAL AFFAIRS.
- SB 92 BAJOIE SPECIAL DISTRICTS
Authorizes issuance of bonds for expansion of the Ernest N. Morial-New Orleans Exhibition Hall Authority. (gov sig)
