

- SB 36 C FIELDS TAX/TAXATION  
Creates a special taxing district for the Concord Homeowners Association.  
Read by title and finally passed, 22 yeas and 11 nays. Title read and adopted and bill ordered to the House. Motion to reconsider tabled.
- SB 42 FONTENOT TAX/TAXATION  
Authorizes a refundable credit against income tax and corporate franchise tax for the purchase by a taxpayer of specialty apparel items from a "PIE contractor" which employs inmates to manufacture such apparel. (1/1/03)  
Reported with amendments. Rules suspended, read by title, committee amendments read and adopted. Ordered engrossed and passed to a third reading.
- SB 47 JOHNSON SPECIAL DISTRICTS  
Authorizes the renewal or levy of taxes or fees in certain special districts in Orleans Parish.  
Read by title and finally passed, 35 yeas and 0 nays. Title read and adopted and bill ordered to the House. Motion to reconsider tabled.
- SB 48 JOHNSON SPECIAL DISTRICTS  
Creates certain neighborhood improvement districts. (gov sig)  
Read by title and finally passed, 36 yeas and 0 nays. Title read and adopted and bill ordered to the House. Motion to reconsider tabled.
- SB 57 THOMAS TAX/SALES  
Provides an exemption from sales and use taxes levied by the state and any political subdivisions on certain prescription drugs. (7/1/02)  
Reported with amendments. Rules suspended, read by title, committee amendments read and adopted. Ordered engrossed and passed to a third reading.
- SB 60 C D JONES TAX/TAXATION  
Authorizes the governing body of a municipality with population exceeding 50,000 but not in excess of 55,000 according to the most recent federal census to levy any form of tax permitted for economic development purposes. (gov sig)  
Read by title and finally passed as amended 35 yeas and 0 nays. Title read and adopted, bill ordered to the House. Motion to reconsider tabled.
- SB 71 BAJOIE TAX/LOCAL  
Exempts the "procurement and administration" of cancer-related and chemotherapy drugs from local sales tax when administered in a physician's office. (7/1/02)  
Read by title. Returned to the calendar subject to call. Rules suspended. Called from the calendar.  
Read by title and finally passed as amended 36 yeas and 0 nays. Title read and adopted, bill ordered to the House. Motion to reconsider tabled.
- SB 72 MALONE TAX/LOCAL  
Authorizes the city of Shreveport to levy and collect an additional sales and use tax. (gov sig)  
Read by title. Returned to the calendar subject to call.
- SB 78 JOHNSON INDUSTRIAL DEVELOPMENT  
Creates the Lower Ninth Ward Economic Development District.  
Read by title and finally passed, 35 yeas and 2 nays. Title read and adopted and bill ordered to the House. Motion to reconsider tabled.
- SB 80 HOLDEN BONDS  
Authorizes the issuance of debt financing instruments known as Grant Anticipation Revenue Vehicles (GARVEE) by the State Bond Commission. (gov sig)  
Reported with amendments. Rules suspended, read by title, committee amendments read and adopted. Ordered engrossed and passed to a third reading.
- SB 86 ELLINGTON TAX/SALES  
Provides for exclusion from state & local sales & use tax for withdrawal, use, distribution, consumption, storage, donation, or disposition of cellular, PCS, or wireless telephones; sale or use of mobile telecommunications services; except retail. (gs)  
Read by title. Returned to the calendar subject to call.

SB 87 BOISSIERE TAX/TAXATION  
Provides for tax credits involving certified capital companies.  
(gov sig)  
Read by title, engrossed and passed to a third reading.

SR 3 MCPHERSON SENATE  
Revises Rules of Order regarding committee reporting of a  
legislative instrument, returning an instrument to the  
calendar, and conference committee procedure regarding bills.  
Read by title. Returned to the calendar subject to call.

SR 26 BAJOIE COMMENDATIONS  
Commends Yolanda Dixon for her volunteer and civic work and  
congratulates her on her presidency of the Junior League of  
Baton Rouge.  
Introduced in the Senate. Read by title, rules suspended,  
adopted.

SCR 41 HINES INDIAN AFFAIRS  
Recognizes the Avoyel-Taensa Tribe/Nation of Louisiana as an  
Indian tribe of Louisiana.  
Introduced in the Senate, rules suspended, read first and  
second time by title and referred to the committee on  
JUDICIARY B.

SCR 42 DARDENNE CONDOLENCES  
Extends condolences on the death of Eugenia Sentell Kennon,  
widow of former governor Robert Kennon.  
Introduced in the Senate. Read by title, rules suspended,

adopted by the vote of 34 yeas and 0 nays and ordered to the House.

- SCR 43 C D JONES MEDICAID  
Directs DHH to take all steps necessary to maximize the reimbursement to schools of the cost of administering and providing medical and related services needed by eligible special education students.  
Introduced in the Senate, rules suspended, read first and second time by title and referred to the committee on HEALTH & WELFARE.
- HB 12 HAMMETT TAX/OCCUPATIONAL  
Removes termination date for the applicability of law relative to determination of the liability of utilities selling electricity or gas in more than one municipality  
Reported favorably, rules suspended, read by title and referred to the Legislative Bureau.
- HB 40 MONTGOMERY TAX/SALES & USE  
Extends the time period for the exemption of certain buses, trucks, and trailers used in interstate commerce  
Reported without Legislative Bureau amendments, read by title and passed to a third reading.
- HB 49 BRUNEAU SPORTS/BOXING-WRESTLING  
Increases the maximum amount of tax proceeds which can be collected by the State Boxing and Wrestling Commission per contest or exhibition  
Reported without Legislative Bureau amendments, read by title and passed to a third reading.
- HB 54 DANIEL TAX/SALES & USE  
Deletes termination date for exemption for purchases of boiler fuel  
Reported without Legislative Bureau amendments, read by title and passed to a third reading.
- HB 73 FARRAR TAX/SALES-USE, LOCAL-EXE  
Authorizes school boards, municipalities, and parishes to exempt farm equipment from local sales and use taxes  
Reported without Legislative Bureau amendments, read by title and passed to a third reading.
- HB 82 DANIEL TAX/SALES-USE, LOCAL-EXE  
Extends the exclusion for certain transactions related to manufactured homes to local sales and use taxes  
Reported without Legislative Bureau amendments, read by title and passed to a third reading.
- HB 95 DEWITT TAX/SALES-USE-EXEMPT  
Excludes certain telephone directories from state taxes  
Reported with amendments. Rules suspended, committee amendments read and adopted. Read by title and referred to the Legislative Bureau.
- HB 130 MONTGOMERY TAX/SALES & USE  
Provides relative to the exemption for automobiles and trucks used as demonstrators  
Reported without Legislative Bureau amendments, read by title and passed to a third reading.
- HB 135 MONTGOMERY TAX/SALES & USE  
Removes termination date for the exclusion for certain transactions involving motor vehicles which are sold for subsequent lease  
Reported without Legislative Bureau amendments, read by title and passed to a third reading.
- HB 141 HAMMETT TAX/TAXATION  
Provides for attribution of revenue of telephone, television, and radio businesses for income tax and corporation franchise purposes  
Reported with amendments. Rules suspended, committee amendments read and adopted. Read by title and referred to the Legislative Bureau.
- HB 266 TOWNSEND TAX/INSURANCE LICENSE  
Provides an increase in licensing taxes for the year 2002  
Reported with amendments. Rules suspended, committee amendments read and adopted. Read by title and referred to the Legislative Bureau.

Creates the Pointe Coupee Parish State Park Steering Committee
