

- SB 14 CAIN FEES/LICENSES/PERMITS  
Provides for senior licensing privileges for saltwater charter boat fishing guides.  
Read third time by title, roll called on final passage, yeas 104, nays 0. Finally passed, ordered to the Senate.
- SB 15 DUPRE PUBLIC HEALTH  
Permits "generic" training for maintenance of individual sewer systems.  
Reported favorably. (13,0) ( ) Referred to the Legislative Bureau.
- SB 20 M SMITH ANIMALS  
Provides relative to the liability of an owner of a dog that kills, wounds, or harasses livestock. (gov sig)  
Read third time by title, roll called on final passage, yeas 102, nays 0. Finally passed, ordered to the Senate.
- SB 30 CAIN VOTERS/VOTING  
Increases the compensation for election commissioners. (gov sig)  
Received in the House from the Senate, rules suspended, read by title.
- SB 40 SCHEDLER JUVENILES  
Rescinds confidentiality provisions regarding juvenile crime victims for the purposes of child abduction alert systems, such as the AMBER Alert network.  
Read third time by title, roll called on final passage, yeas 102, nays 0. Finally passed, ordered to the Senate.
- SB 47 MCPHERSON HUNTERS/HUNTING  
Constitutional amendment to preserve the freedom to hunt, fish and trap subject to regulation, restriction, or prohibition imposed pursuant to law. (2/3-CA13s1(A))  
Received in the House from the Senate, rules suspended, read by title.
- SB 64 M SMITH PRESCRIPTION  
Provides for prescription of debts due public institutions of higher education in ten years. (gov sig)  
Received in the House from the Senate, rules suspended, read by title.
- SB 72 DUPRE DWI  
Prohibits mail order purchasing of an ignition interlock device required as a condition of probation for a DWI offense.  
Received in the House from the Senate, rules suspended, read by title.
- SB 76 ELLINGTON SHERIFFS  
Requires that the insurance premiums of the sheriff and certain deputy sheriffs of LaSalle Parish shall be paid in full from the sheriff's general fund.

- SB 138 DARDENNE INSURERS  
Requires health insurance policies to provide coverage for services rendered by registered nurse first assistants.  
Read by title, under the rules, referred to the Committee on INSURANCE.
- SB 149 M SMITH FORESTRY  
Provides for the sale of undivided interest in timber. (gov sig)  
Read by title, returned to the calendar subject to call.
- SB 155 SCHEDLER COUNSELING/GUIDANCE  
Provides for the documentation and verification of national board-certified school counselors and specifies the timing of the initial salary supplement payment. (gov sig)  
Received in the House from the Senate, rules suspended, read by title.
- SB 178 DUPRE CRIME/PUNISHMENT  
Increases the penalties for the crime of reckless operation of a vehicle.  
Read by title, under the rules, referred to the Committee on ADMIN CRIM JUSTICE.

SB 179 DUPRE MOTOR VEHICLES  
Creates the offense of aggressive driving and provides for a responsive verdict of aggressive driving to reckless operation of a motor vehicle.

SB 225 THEUNISSEN SCHOOLS  
Constitutional amendment to authorize BESE to provide for the operation of failed schools, including receiving, controlling, and expending certain funds. (2/3-CA13s1(A))

Authorizes DSS to release non-identifying medical or genetic information to former minor foster children or their representatives.

SB 343 MCPHERSON MILITARY AFFAIRS  
Creates the Military Funeral Honors Program.  
Received in the House from the Senate, rules suspended, read by title.

SB 346 DARDENNE DNA  
Provides relative to the taking or drawing of DNA samples from arrested or convicted felons.

SB 354 MCPHERSON LIABILITY  
Provides for limits the liability of an equine activity sponsor, an equine professional, or other person for injuries or death resulting from equine activities.

SB 405 CHAISSON DWI

Eliminates requirement that financial institutions file certificate of authority, incorporation, amendments, and other documents with the secretary of state in addition to OFI and parish records. (gov sig)

SB 746 M SMITH FUNDS/FUNDING  
Prescribes audit requirements for certain state entities with annual revenues of \$50,000 or less. (7/1/03)
