Requires the candidae to certify certain information in the notice of candidacy and for actions objecting to candidacy
Read by title, amended, passed to 3rd reading - regular calendar.
- SB 8 GAUTREUX COURTS
Provides for an additional \$20 court cost for juvenile offender services for the city court of Morgan City.
Read by title, amended, passed to 3rd reading - regular calendar.
- SB 9 MCPHERSON SHERIFFS
Enables sheriffs to participate in the matched portion of an eligible deferred compensation plan offered to state and local government employees.
Read by title, amended, passed to 3rd reading - regular calendar.
- SB 11 DUPRE VOTERS/VOTING
Changes poll hours, expands absentee voting period, allows qualified voters to vote absentee in person, provides for counting absentee vote of voter who dies before polls open
Read by title, amended, passed to 3rd reading - regular calendar.
- SB 21 CAIN FUNDS/FUNDING
Revises dedications of money in the Vernon Parish Community Improvement Fund. (7/1/03)
Reported with amendments. (11,0) (Regular) Referred to the Legislative Bureau.
- SB 24 DUPRE AMUSEMENTS/SPORTS
Limits the authority of the state fire marshal to enter certain premises in order to inspect air-supported amusement structures.
Read third time by title, roll called on final passage, yeas 97, nays 0. Finally passed, ordered to the Senate.
- SB 39 DUPRE MOTOR VEHICLES
Authorizes placement of America's WETLAND: Campaign to Save Coastal Louisiana stickers on public vehicles. (gov sig)
Read third time by title, roll called on final passage, yeas 100, nays 0. Finally passed, ordered to the Senate.
- SB 42 MCPHERSON PUBLIC CONTRACTS
Requires public entities issuing an addendum to a bid within a period of seven days prior to opening of the bids to notify the project's prime bidders by fax or e-mail on the date of the addendum issuance. (gov sig)
Read third time by title, roll called on final passage, yeas 98, nays 0. Finally passed, ordered to the Senate.
- SB 53 C FIELDS AUTOMOBILE INSURANCE
Restricts limitation of recovery for uninsured motorist to accidents occurring while operating a motor vehicle.
Read third time by title, roll called on final passage, yeas 100, nays 1. Finally passed, ordered to the Senate.
- SB 60 LENTINI TRESPASS
Constitutional amendment to provide that a person must have authorization, either express, legal or implied, to enter upon or remain upon the private property of another, whether movable or immovable. (2/3-CA13s1(A))
Read by title, returned to the calendar subject to call.
- SB 61 C D JONES SPECIAL DISTRICTS
Creates the Monroe and Northeast Louisiana Technology and Business Incubation Center.
Reported favorably. (11,0) (Regular) Referred to the Legislative Bureau.
- SB 62 MCPHERSON CIVIL PROCEDURE
Provides that the mother is the proper party to enforce certain rights or an obligations of an unemancipated minor under certain circumstances.
Read third time by title, roll called on final passage, yeas 101, nays 0. Finally passed, ordered to the Senate.

- SB 68 M SMITH LOCAL OFFICIALS
Provides that the chief of police for the Village of Dry Prong be appointed rather than elected.
Read third time by title, roll called on final passage, yeas 99, nays 0. Finally passed, ordered to the Senate.
- SB 70 GAUTREAUX MOTOR VEHICLES
Prohibits driving a motor vehicle with a television capable of receiving any pre-recorded visual presentation unless the TV is behind the driver's seat or not visible to the driver while he is operating the vehicle and provides for certain exceptions.
Read by title, returned to the calendar subject to call.
Called from the calendar.
Read third time by title, amended, roll called on final passage, yeas 99, nays 2. Finally passed, ordered to the Senate.
- SB 76 ELLINGTON SHERIFFS
Requires that the insurance premiums of the sheriff and certain deputy sheriffs of LaSalle Parish shall be paid in full from the sheriff's general fund.
Read by title, passed to 3rd reading - regular calendar.
- SB 84 THEUNISSEN FUNDS/FUNDING
Extends authorization for the appropriation of state funds for the Monkey Island Ferry to July 1, 2005.
Read third time by title, roll called on final passage, yeas 96, nays 0. Finally passed, ordered to the Senate.
- SB 104 BARHAM SEIZURES/SALES
Provides exemption for certain vehicles from seizure.
Read third time by title, roll called on final passage, yeas 99, nays 1. Finally passed, ordered to the Senate.
- SB 106 C FIELDS COMMERCIAL REGULATIONS
Prohibits a retail business from requiring or obtaining an individual's personal information when transacting a cash sale.
Read third time by title, roll called on final passage, yeas 89, nays 7. Finally passed, ordered to the Senate.
- SB 108 HOYT CRIME/PUNISHMENT
Authorizes each judicial district court to establish job intervention programs for certain nonviolent first-time offenders. (gov sig)
Read by title, passed to 3rd reading - regular calendar.
- SB 120 LENTINI PUBLIC CONTRACTS
Authorizes a parish or municipality with a population exceeding 425,000 to require a contractor to pay for additional costs incurred for inspection of a project under certain conditions. (gov sig)
Reported favorably. (12,0) (Regular) Referred to the Legislative Bureau.
- SB 133 HOYT PUBLIC CONTRACTS
Makes inapplicable any preference for certain expanded clay aggregate products produced in the state (gov sig)
Reported favorably. (13,0) (Regular) Referred to the Legislative Bureau.
- SB 141 DUPRE SCHOOL BUS DRIVERS
Provides for a restriction to commercial driver's licenses which would permit operation only of a school bus under certain circumstances.
Read third time by title, roll called on final passage, yeas 94, nays 0. Finally passed, ordered to the Senate.
- SB 146 M SMITH LIBRARIES
Authorizes the expenditure of a tax passage for Winn Parish library boards.

- SB 147 M SMITH FORESTRY
Provides an exception for treated wood poles and piling from preferences for products produced or manufactured in the state. (gov sig)

Modifies emergency response standards for permits for certain solid waste disposal facilities. (gov sig)

- SB 227 HOLLIS GROUP BENEFITS PROGRAM
Prohibits the state from assessing any health and accident insurance deficits to the plan members.

Changes certain definitions for purposes of medical malpractice claims.
Read third time by title, roll called on final passage, yeas 100, nays 0. Finally passed, ordered to the Senate.
- SB 251 LENTINI TRUSTS
Provides for matters that are relative to the Louisiana Trust Code, the beneficiaries of a trust, the powers of a trustee, and the principal and income of a trust.
Read third time by title, roll called on final passage, yeas 101, nays 1. Finally passed, ordered to the Senate.
- SB 255 DARDENNE CIVIL PROCEDURE
Provides for the revival of money judgments by ex parte motion.
Reported with amendments. (7,0) (Regular) Referred to the Legislative Bureau.
- SB 260 ELLINGTON SPECIAL DISTRICTS
Provides for revisions to the LaSalle Economic Development District.
Read third time by title, roll called on final passage, yeas 101, nays 0. Finally passed, ordered to the Senate.
- SB 265 HOYT TRAFFIC
Removes prohibitions of certain agencies contracting with collection agencies and credit information agencies for services relative to unpaid parking fines.

SB 291 M SMITH LEGIS POWERS/FUNCTIONS
 Declares the Winnfield-based "Uncle Earl's Hog Dog Trials" as the official state "Uncle Earl's Hog Dog Trials". (gov sig)
 Read by title, passed to 3rd reading - regular calendar.

SB 300 CHAISSON LOCAL OFFICIALS
 Provides for the appointment of public administrators for successions in certain parishes.
 Read third time by title, roll called on final passage, yeas 99, nays 0. Finally passed, ordered to the Senate.

SB 314 SCHEDLER HEALTH/HOSPITALS DEPT
 Changes the number of months in the initial term of the Department of Health and Hospitals contracts for fiscal intermediary services from between thirty-six months and sixty months.

SB 315 SCHEDLER FEES/LICENSES/PERMITS
 Creates the Perfusion Licensure Act to provide for the licensing of medical technicians to practice perfusion.

SB 318 ELLINGTON FAMILY LAW
 Provides for certain parties to be notified prior to an adoption records hearing.
 Read by title, amended, passed to 3rd reading - regular calendar.

SB 322 LENTINI MALPRACTICE
 Provides relative to expert opinions rendered by a medical review panel.
 Read third time by title, roll called on final passage, yeas 98, nays 0. Finally passed, ordered to the Senate.

SB 323 LENTINI ROADS/HIGHWAYS
 Requires construction involving lane closures on controlled access interstate highways during off-peak hours.
 Reported favorably. (11,0) (Regular) Referred to the Legislative Bureau.

SB 336 C FIELDS WORKERS' COMPENSATION
 Prohibits suspension of surgical procedures during pendency of appeal.
 Read third time by title, roll called on final passage, yeas 82, nays 13. Finally passed, ordered to the Senate.

SB 338 CRAVINS MUNICIPALITIES
 Abolishes the legislative charter of the town of Grand Coteau and provides that the town shall be subject to the Lawrason Act. (7/1/03)
 Read by title, passed to 3rd reading - regular calendar.

SB 340 IRONS TAX/TAXATION
 Requires political subdivisions to provide the vehicle commissioner with information concerning their boundaries for purposes of vehicle sales tax collection.
 Read third time by title, amended, roll called on final passage, yeas 97, nays 2. Finally passed, ordered to the Senate.

SB 346 DARDENNE DNA
 Provides relative to the taking or drawing of DNA samples from arrested or convicted felons.

SB 349 HOLDEN FUNDS/FUNDING

SB 354 MCPHERSON LIABILITY
 Provides for limits the liability of an equine activity sponsor, an equine professional, or other person for injuries

Provides that inspections of amusement rides and attractions be performed by an inspector who is not the operator of the amusement ride or attraction to be inspected.

SB 470 HOYT FEES/LICENSES/PERMITS
 Authorizes special permit to move houses and provides for

SB 473 HINES SUCCESSIONS
 Provides for inheritance rights of children born after death of
 the parent.

SB 497 HOLLIS GOVERNMENTAL REGULATIONS
 Provides for the building code for state-owned buildings and
