

- SB 14 CAIN FEES/LICENSES/PERMITS
Provides for senior licensing privileges for saltwater charter boat fishing guides.
Reported with amendments. Rules suspended, read by title, committee amendments read and adopted. Ordered engrossed and passed to a third reading.
- SB 27 HAINKEL HUNTERS/HUNTING
Prohibits the use of aircraft for hunting, shooting or taking of wild turkey or white-tailed deer.
Reported with amendments. Rules suspended, read by title, committee amendments read and adopted. Ordered engrossed and passed to a third reading.
- SB 29 DUPRE COASTAL RESOURCES
Designates the loss of coastal wetlands to be our "state crisis". (gov sig)
Reported favorably, rules suspended, read by title, ordered engrossed and passed to a third reading.
- SB 45 MCPHERSON FISH/FISHING
Authorizes the Wildlife and Fisheries Commission to establish a program for removal of abandoned crab traps.

- SB 50 THEUNISSEN SCHOOLS
Eliminates caps on teacher and support person of the year awards and provides for school board approval.

- SB 68 M SMITH LOCAL OFFICIALS
Provides that the chief of police for the Village of Dry Prong be appointed rather than elected.

- SB 83 THEUNISSEN EDUCATION DEPARTMENT
Re-creates the Department of Education and its agencies. (6/30/03)

- SB 110 HINES STUDENTS
Provides with regard to disciplining a student in possession of a small knife.

- SB 112 THEUNISSEN EDUCATION ACCOUNTABILITY
Allows distinguished educators to extend their employment up to 6 years at certain low performing schools. (gov sig)

- SB 126 THEUNISSEN TEACHERS
Increases membership on the State Advisory Commission on Teacher Education and Certification from 11 to 13 members. (gov sig)

- SB 128 THEUNISSEN TEACHERS
Establishes the principal of the year awards by law and allows both the outstanding state teachers and principals to receive certain monetary awards from private sources without violating the ethics code. (gov sig)

- SB 146 M SMITH LIBRARIES
Authorizes the expenditure of a tax passage for Winn Parish library boards.

- SB 175 SCHEDLER FINANCIAL INSTITUTIONS

Repeals authority for political subdivisions to invest in certain commercial paper of domestic corporations.

Authorizes the exchange of certain land in Sabine parish owned by Blue Lake Village, Inc. (gov sig)

Provides for the membership of the board of commissioners for the Terrebonne Parish Fire District Number Five. (gov sig)

- SB 363 THEUNISSEN SPECIAL DISTRICTS

- SB 663 HEITMEIER GAMING
