Permits "generic" training for maintenance of individual sewer systems.  
Read by title and finally passed, 35 yeas and 0 nays. Title read and adopted and bill ordered to the House. Motion to reconsider tabled.
- SB 17 DUPRE WILDLIFE/FISHERIES DEPT  
Provides for nominations to the governor for appointments to the Louisiana Wildlife and Fisheries Commission.  
Reported favorably, rules suspended, read by title, ordered engrossed and passed to a third reading.
- SB 20 M SMITH ANIMALS  
Provides relative to the liability of an owner of a dog that kills, wounds, or harasses livestock. (gov sig)  
Read by title and finally passed, 37 yeas and 0 nays. Title read and adopted and bill ordered to the House. Motion to reconsider tabled.
- SB 31 DUPRE PORTS/HARBORS/TERMINALS  
Provides for compensation of members of the Greater Lafourche Port Commission. (gov sig)  
Reported favorably, rules suspended, read by title, ordered engrossed and passed to a third reading.
- SB 38 IRONS CURRICULA  
Requires the free enterprise curriculum to include instruction in personal finance beginning with the 2004-2005 school year. (gov sig)  
Reported favorably, rules suspended, read by title, ordered engrossed and passed to a third reading.
- SB 63 HOLLIS SENATE  
Corrects various statutes to reflect the correct name of the Senate Commerce Committee.  
Read by title and finally passed as amended 36 yeas and 0 nays. Title read and adopted, bill ordered to the House. Motion to reconsider tabled.
- SB 77 MOUNT CHILDREN  
Provides relative to proximity of licensed day care centers to certain alcohol service providers and places day care centers in drug free zones.

- SB 78 DARDENNE AIRCRAFT/AVIATION  
Redefines the term "fixed base operator".

- SB 84 THEUNISSEN FUNDS/FUNDING  
Extends authorization for the appropriation of state funds for the Monkey Island Ferry to July 1, 2005.

- SB 100 CAIN ROADS/HIGHWAYS  
Designates portions of Highway 110 in the town of Merryville as the "C.E. Buddy Slaydon Memorial Drive."

- SB 101 CAIN ROADS/HIGHWAYS

- SB 131 HAINKEL RETIREMENT SYSTEMS  
Provides annual cost-of-living adjustment for judges and widows of such judges who did not opt to become members of the Louisiana State Employees' Retirement System. (gov sig)  
Reported favorably, rules suspended, read by title, ordered

engrossed and passed to a third reading.

- SB 132 LAMBERT SPECIAL DISTRICTS  
Increases the membership of the River Region Cancer Screening and Early Detection District Board of Commissioners.  
Read by title and finally passed, 37 yeas and 0 nays. Title read and adopted and bill ordered to the House. Motion to reconsider tabled.
- SB 144 C ROMERO MOTOR VEHICLES  
Creates the Junior Golf special prestige license plate.  
Reported favorably, rules suspended, read by title, ordered engrossed and passed to a third reading.
- SB 147 M SMITH FORESTRY  
Provides an exception for treated wood poles and piling from preferences for products produced or manufactured in the state. (gov sig)  
Read by title and finally passed, 37 yeas and 0 nays. Title read and adopted and bill ordered to the House. Motion to reconsider tabled.
- SB 149 M SMITH FORESTRY  
Provides for the sale of undivided interest in timber. (gov sig)

- SB 150 DUPRE CONTRACTS  
Provides that contingent fee agreement between an insured and a public adjuster is against public policy and is null and void.

- SB 162 C FIELDS CIVIL PROCEDURE  
Constitutional amendment to limit appellate jurisdiction of a court of appeal to questions of law. (2/3-CA13s1(A))  
Read by title. Returned to the calendar subject to call as amended.
- SB 172 MARIONNEAUX ROADS/HIGHWAYS  
Designates the portion of LA 75 within the city of St. Gabriel as the "Martin Luther King , Jr. Parkway."  
Reported favorably, rules suspended, read by title, ordered engrossed and passed to a third reading.
- SB 210 BARHAM PUBLIC LANDS  
Authorizes the Department of Wildlife and Fisheries to sell or exchange title to certain property in Ouachita Parish. (gov sig)  
Reported with amendments. Rules suspended, read by title, committee amendments read and adopted. Ordered engrossed and passed to a third reading.
- SB 214 DUPRE FUNDS/FUNDING  
Const. amend. authorizing certain uses for nonrecurring revenue, authorizing certain deposits into Wetlands Conservation and Restoration Fd, and eliminating the cap on mineral revenues that can be part of the balance in the fund. (2/3-CA13s1(A))  
Read by title and finally passed as amended 37 yeas and 1 nays. Title read and adopted, bill ordered to the House. Motion to reconsider tabled.
- SB 223 BARHAM TRANSPORTATION/DEV DEPT  
Constitutional amendment to provide for certain TIMED project descriptions. (2/3-CA13s1(A))  
Reported favorably, rules suspended, read by title, ordered engrossed and passed to a third reading.
- SB 225 THEUNISSEN SCHOOLS  
Constitutional amendment to authorize BESE to provide for the operation of failed schools, including receiving, controlling, and expending certain funds. (2/3-CA13s1(A))

- SB 227 HOLLIS GROUP BENEFITS PROGRAM  
Prohibits the state from assessing any health and accident insurance deficits to the plan members.  
Read by title and finally passed, 25 yeas and 11 nays. Title read and adopted and bill ordered to the House. Motion to reconsider tabled.
- SB 228 HOLLIS GOVERNMENT ORGANIZATION  
Abolishes the state office of rural development and the office

of urban affairs and development. (gov sig)  
Rules suspended, recalled from committee.  
Withdrawn from the files of the Senate.

- SB 235 DUPRE TEACHERS  
Increases the maximum duration a local school board is required to grant leave without pay to the president of large statewide professional organizations from two years to six consecutive years.  
Reported with amendments. Rules suspended, read by title, committee amendments read and adopted. Ordered engrossed and passed to a third reading.
- SB 241 MARIONNEAUX STATE EMPLOYEE RET  
Provides cost-of-living adjustment for members of Louisiana State Employees' Retirement System who retire prior to age fifty-five. (gov sig)  
Reported favorably, rules suspended, read by title, ordered engrossed and passed to a third reading.
- SB 305 SCHEDLER MEDICAID  
Requires DHH to create an optional Medicaid program for persons with disabilities to buy-in to medicaid coverage so they can return to work and maintain eligibility.  
Reported with amendments. Rules suspended, read by title, committee amendments read and adopted. Ordered engrossed and passed to a third reading.
- SB 312 BOISSIERE STATE POLICE RET FUND  
Provides retroactive eligibility for survivor benefits in limited circumstances where surviving spouse was married to decedent for less than two years prior to death. (gov sig)  
Read by title and finally passed, 35 yeas and 0 nays. Title read and adopted and bill ordered to the House. Motion to reconsider tabled.
- SB 338 CRAVINS MUNICIPALITIES  
Abolishes the legislative charter of the town of Grand Coteau and provides that the town shall be subject to the Lawrason Act. (7/1/03)  
Reported favorably, rules suspended, read by title, ordered engrossed and passed to a third reading.
- SB 340 IRONS TAX/TAXATION  
Requires political subdivisions to provide the vehicle commissioner with information concerning their boundaries for purposes of vehicle sales tax collection.  
Read by title and finally passed as amended 34 yeas and 0 nays. Title read and adopted, bill ordered to the House. Motion to reconsider tabled.
- SB 367 SCHEDLER PUBLIC SFTY/CORRECT DEPT  
Requires the office of motor vehicles to collect certain statistical information. (gov sig)

- SB 390 SCHEDLER MUNICIPAL EMPLOYEE RET  
Provides relative to membership of elected officials with a term limitation of less than ten years. (gov sig)

- SB 399 FONTENOT STATE EMPLOYEE RET  
Provides for eligibility for cost-of-living increases. (gov sig)  
Read by title and finally passed as amended 34 yeas and 0 nays. Title read and adopted, bill ordered to the House. Motion to reconsider tabled.
- SB 426 BOISSIERE PAROCHIAL EMPLOYEES RET  
Provides for the calculation of benefits for members of the Parochial Employees' Retirement System of Louisiana. (gov sig)  
Read by title and finally passed as amended 37 yeas and 0 nays. Title read and adopted, bill ordered to the House. Motion to reconsider tabled.
- SB 431 BAJOIE IMMOVABLE PROPERTY  
Provides relative to the acquisition of blighted property. (gov sig)  
Reported with amendments. Rules suspended, read by title, committee amendments read and adopted. Ordered engrossed and passed to a third reading.
- SB 450 CRAVINS STATE EMPLOYEE RET  
Provides for retirement of judges and court officers with ten years of creditable service after attaining age sixty. (gov

sig)

Read by title and finally passed as amended 36 yeas and 1 nays. Title read and adopted, bill ordered to the House. Motion to reconsider tabled.

- SB 453 CRAVINS HOSPITALS  
Removes the University Medical Center of Lafayette from the Louisiana State University Health Sciences Center-Health Care Services Division. (gov sig)  
Rules suspended; read by title, recommitted to the Committee on HEALTH & WELFARE.
- SB 568 DUPRE FUNDS/FUNDING  
Authorizes certain uses for nonrecurring revenues, authorizes certain deposits into the Wetlands Conservation and Restoration Fund, and increases the cap on mineral revenues that can be part of the balance in that fund. (7/1/04)  
Read by title and finally passed as amended 37 yeas and 0 nays. Title read and adopted, bill ordered to the House. Motion to reconsider tabled.
