- SB 17 DUPRE WILDLIFE/FISHERIES DEPT
Provides for nominations to the governor for appointments to the Louisiana Wildlife and Fisheries Commission.
Read by title. Returned to the calendar subject to call.
- SB 23 MARIONNEAUX APPOINTED OFFICIALS
Provides that certain persons appointed to boards and commissions be reconfirmed each legislative term.
Rules suspended; reported with amendments.
- SB 26 THEUNISSEN VETERANS
Provides for membership on the Louisiana Veterans Affairs Commission. (gov sig)
Read by title and finally passed as amended 35 yeas and 0 nays. Title read and adopted, bill ordered to the House.
Motion to reconsider tabled.
- SB 30 CAIN VOTERS/VOTING
Increases the compensation for election commissioners. (gov sig)
Rules suspended; reported with amendments.
- SB 32 DUPRE SPECIAL DISTRICTS
Provides for appointment to the board of commissioners of the Terrebonne Levee and Conservation District if a vacancy occurs.
Read by title and finally passed, 33 yeas and 0 nays. Title read and adopted and bill ordered to the House. Motion to reconsider tabled.
- SB 33 DUPRE SPECIAL DISTRICTS
Provides for the membership of the board of commissioners of the South Lafourche Levee District.
Read by title and finally passed as amended 34 yeas and 1 nays. Title read and adopted, bill ordered to the House.
Motion to reconsider tabled.
- SB 34 DUPRE SPECIAL DISTRICTS
Provides for membership of the board of commissioners of the North Lafourche Conservation, Levee and Drainage District.

Ordered engrossed and passed to a third reading.
- SB 53 C FIELDS AUTOMOBILE INSURANCE
Restricts limitation of recovery for uninsured motorist to accidents occurring while operating a motor vehicle.
Read by title and finally passed, 33 yeas and 1 nays. Title read and adopted and bill ordered to the House. Motion to reconsider tabled.
- SB 55 C FIELDS AUTOMOBILE INSURANCE
Prohibits insurers from cancelling an automobile insurance policy under certain circumstances.
Read by title and finally passed as amended 32 yeas and 4 nays. Title read and adopted, bill ordered to the House.
Motion to reconsider tabled.
- SB 56 C FIELDS INSURERS
Prohibits certain uses of credit information in establishing rates for personal insurance.

- SB 60 LENTINI TRESPASS
Constitutional amendment to provide that a person must have

authorization, either express, legal or implied, to enter upon or remain upon the private property of another, whether movable or immovable. (2/3-CA13s1(A))

- SB 64 M SMITH PRESCRIPTION
Provides for prescription of debts due public institutions of higher education in ten years. (gov sig)
Rules suspended.
Read by title, committee amendments read and adopted.
Ordered engrossed and passed to a third reading.
- SB 71 DUPRE DWI
Provides for penalties for a driver who refuses to submit to a chemical test after his involvement in a fatal crash or a crash resulting in serious injury which involves alcohol.

- SB 72 DUPRE DWI
Prohibits mail order purchasing of an ignition interlock device required as a condition of probation for a DWI offense.
Rules suspended; reported with amendments.
- SB 76 ELLINGTON SHERIFFS
Requires that the insurance premiums of the sheriff and certain deputy sheriffs of LaSalle Parish shall be paid in full from the sheriff's general fund.

- SB 98 LENTINI CRIME/PUNISHMENT
Revises provisions for limitation of access to immovable property under the crime of criminal trespass and provides for penalties.

Creates the Ground Water Conservation Commission.
Rules suspended; reported with amendments.
- SB 108 HOYT CRIME/PUNISHMENT
Authorizes each judicial district court to establish job intervention programs for certain nonviolent first-time offenders. (gov sig)
Rules suspended; reported with amendments.
- SB 131 HAINKEL RETIREMENT SYSTEMS
Provides annual cost-of-living adjustment for judges and widows of such judges who did not opt to become members of the Louisiana State Employees' Retirement System. (gov sig)
Read by title and finally passed, 30 yeas and 4 nays. Title read and adopted and bill ordered to the House. Motion to reconsider tabled.
- SB 143 DUPRE DWI
Increases penalties relative to first or second offense driving while intoxicated when the offender has a BAC of 0.20 or more and prohibits a restricted driver's license under certain circumstances.
Rules suspended; reported with amendments.
- SB 155 SCHEDLER COUNSELING/GUIDANCE
Provides for the documentation and verification of national board-certified school counselors and specifies the timing of the initial salary supplement payment. (gov sig)
Rules suspended.
Read by title, engrossed and passed to a third reading.
- SB 179 DUPRE MOTOR VEHICLES
Creates the offense of aggressive driving and provides for a responsive verdict of aggressive driving to reckless operation of a motor vehicle.

- SB 223 BARHAM TRANSPORTATION/DEV DEPT
Constitutional amendment to provide for certain TIMED project descriptions. (2/3-CA13s1(A))

- SB 235 DUPRE TEACHERS
Increases the maximum duration a local school board is required to grant leave without pay to the president of large statewide professional organizations from two years to six consecutive years.

- SB 241 MARIONNEAUX STATE EMPLOYEE RET
Provides cost-of-living adjustment for members of Louisiana State Employees' Retirement System who retire prior to age fifty-five. (gov sig)

- SB 245 HAINKEL INSURANCE DEPARTMENT
Limits the authority of the Louisiana Insurance Rating Commission. (1/1/04)
Rules suspended; reported favorably.
- SB 260 ELLINGTON SPECIAL DISTRICTS
Provides for revisions to the LaSalle Economic Development District.
Rules suspended.
Read by title, engrossed and passed to a third reading.
- SB 270 C FIELDS WORKERS' COMPENSATION
Requires copies of correspondence to physician by an employer be copied to employee.

Read by title, committee amendments read and adopted.
Ordered engrossed and passed to a third reading.
- SB 296 DARDENNE DENTISTRY
Revises the dental practice act relative to judicial review of adjudication.
Rules suspended; reported with amendments.
- SB 338 CRAVINS MUNICIPALITIES
Abolishes the legislative charter of the town of Grand Coteau and provides that the town shall be subject to the Lawrason Act. (7/1/03)
Read by title and finally passed, 35 yeas and 0 nays. Title read and adopted and bill ordered to the House. Motion to reconsider tabled.
- SB 343 MCPHERSON MILITARY AFFAIRS
Creates the Military Funeral Honors Program.
Rules suspended; reported favorably.
- SB 346 DARDENNE DNA
Provides relative to the taking or drawing of DNA samples from arrested or convicted felons.
Rules suspended.
Read by title, committee amendments read and adopted.
Ordered reengrossed and passed to a third reading.
- SB 367 SCHEDLER PUBLIC SFTY/CORRECT DEPT
Requires the office of motor vehicles to collect certain statistical information. (gov sig)
Read by title and finally passed, 32 yeas and 3 nays. Title read and adopted and bill ordered to the House. Motion to reconsider tabled.
- SB 381 SCHEDLER FUNDS/FUNDING
Removes the authority of the Department of Environmental Quality to administer the Drinking Water Revolving Loan Fund Program and authorizes the Department of Health and Hospitals to administer the fund. (gov sig)
Rules suspended; reported favorably.
- SB 390 SCHEDLER MUNICIPAL EMPLOYEE RET
Provides relative to membership of elected officials with a term limitation of less than ten years. (gov sig)
Read by title and finally passed, 32 yeas and 0 nays. Title read and adopted and bill ordered to the House. Motion to reconsider tabled.
- SB 421 MCPHERSON CONTRACTORS
Clarifies that property owners are exempt from obtaining a contractor's license from the Louisiana State Licensing Board for Contractors for certain construction or improvements to their property.
Rules suspended; reported favorably.
- SB 431 BAJOIE IMMOVABLE PROPERTY
Provides relative to the acquisition of blighted property. (gov sig)
Read by title and finally passed as amended 34 yeas and 0 nays. Title read and adopted, bill ordered to the House. Motion to reconsider tabled.

- SB 463 MCPHERSON PUBLIC LANDS
 Authorizes transfer of Fort Randolph and Fort Buhlow properties in Rapides Parish from the Department of Health and Hospitals to the Department of Culture, Recreation and Tourism under certain conditions.
 Rules suspended.
 Read by title, committee amendments read and adopted.
 Ordered engrossed and passed to a third reading.
- SB 479 CHAISSON ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES
 Defines passengers in the "open container" prohibition and provides exclusions for certain operators, passengers, and areas of the motor vehicle.

- SB 518 C D JONES CRIME/PUNISHMENT
 Creates the reentry preparation program within the Dept. of Public Safety and Corrections and requires each institution have a transition specialist.

- SB 551 B JONES TAX/TAXATION
 Enacts the Uniform Local Sales Tax Code [the UTC] by gathering various provisions applicable to local sales and use taxes and requires local sales tax to be administered and collected in conformity with such provisions. (7/1/03)
 Rules suspended.
 Read by title, committee amendments read and adopted.
 Ordered engrossed and passed to a third reading.
- SB 554 DUPRE DWI
 Provides for the suspension of driver's license for one year for second and subsequent DWI offenses, with no exceptions, and for installation of an ignition interlock device on all the vehicles of an offender for 6 months after such suspens
 Rules suspended; reported with amendments.
- SB 565 IRONS MARRIAGE
 Provides exceptions from the seventy-two hour delay for certain marriage ceremonies in Orleans Parish.
 Rules suspended. Called from the calendar.
 Read by title and finally passed as amended 23 yeas and 6 nays. Title read and adopted, bill ordered to the House.
 Motion to reconsider tabled.
- SB 567 LENTINI INSURANCE POLICIES
 Prohibits the surrender of a defendant for nonpayment of bail bond premium. (gov sig)
 Rules suspended; reported with amendments.
- SB 574 DARDENNE FUNDS/FUNDING
 Provides for transition of assistance recipients from cash assistance to self-reliance.
 Read by title and finally passed as amended 34 yeas and 0 nays. Title read and adopted, bill ordered to the House.
 Motion to reconsider tabled.
- SB 590 DARDENNE DENTISTRY
 Revises the dental practice act relative to administration of certain types of anesthesia. (2/3-CA7s2.1(A))
 Rules suspended; reported with amendments.
- SB 596 CHAISSON COURTS
 Provides relative to reimbursement of expenses for judges of the courts of appeal.
 Rules suspended; reported favorably.
- SB 597 MCPHERSON PUBLIC LANDS
 Authorizes the state to transfer a certain tract of land in Rapides Parish to the England Economic and Industrial Development District. (gov sig)

- SB 636 HEITMEIER STATE EMPLOYEE RET
Provides for receipt of credit for military service for any legislator serving on January 1, 1997, who is a military retiree.

- SB 663 HEITMEIER GAMING
Provides the definition of "Louisiana Business" for purposes of the Louisiana Gaming Control Law.

- SB 665 HEITMEIER ROADS/HIGHWAYS
Designates the portion of LA 23 that is in the city of Gretna as the "Mel Ott Parkway".
Read by title and finally passed, 33 yeas and 0 nays. Title read and adopted and bill ordered to the House. Motion to reconsider tabled.
- SB 668 HEITMEIER TELEPHONES
Authorizes certain telemarketing calls having an intent to complete a sales presentation at a later face-to-face meeting.

Requires hospitals to display in emergency rooms, laws which mandate reporting instances of abuse and neglect.
Rules suspended; reported favorably.
- SB 715 B JONES FISH/FISHING
Regulates the use of trotlines on Lake D'Arbonne.
Read by title and finally passed, 34 yeas and 0 nays. Title read and adopted and bill ordered to the House. Motion to reconsider tabled.
- SB 716 B JONES FISH/FISHING
Regulates the use of yo-yo's or trigger devices on Lake D'Arbonne.
Read by title and finally passed, 34 yeas and 0 nays. Title read and adopted and bill ordered to the House. Motion to reconsider tabled.
- SB 721 HAINKEL INSURANCE RATES
Creates a flexible rating process for property and casualty insurance rates.
Rules suspended; reported with amendments.
- SB 727 MCPHERSON FUNDS/FUNDING
Provides that revenues generated by private entities from the operation, management or control of public lands or facilities shall be subject to legislative review.

- SB 756 HOYT CRIME/PUNISHMENT
Removes from the crimes of simple rape and sexual battery the exception provided if the offender is the spouse of the victim.

Authorizes the Public Service Commission to research the establishment of a statewide "211" information and referral telephone system.

- SB 791 BARHAM TAX/SALES
Provides that tangible personal property shall not include other constructions permanently attached to the ground for local tax purposes. (7/1/03)
Designated a duplicate of HB 1658.
Read by title and finally passed as amended 35 yeas and 0 nays. Title read and adopted, bill ordered to the House. Motion to reconsider tabled.
- SB 796 CRAVINS JUVENILE JUSTICE
Creates a Louisiana Risk Review Panel to evaluate the risk of danger posed by juveniles in order to make a decision as to

whether a juvenile can be released from confinement.

- SB 800 BAJOIE IMMOVABLE PROPERTY
Provides for redemptive period affecting post-adjudication donation of abandoned or blighted property by parishes and municipalities. (gov sig)
Read by title and finally passed as amended 34 yeas and 0 nays. Title read and adopted, bill ordered to the House. Motion to reconsider tabled.
- SB 826 C D JONES MUNICIPALITIES
Authorizes the city of Monroe to dismantle and remove dangerous and dilapidated structures within the city limits.

- SB 828 BOISSIERE GAMING
Authorizes slot machine gaming at eligible live horse racing facility in Orleans Parish.

- SB 833 HOLDEN SCHOOLS
Provides a salary supplement to school psychologists who obtain a national certification when funds are available.

Requires the Tax Court establish fees for services rendered by the court and its small claims division. (gov sig)

Requires the width of the fender, cover, or other device on a motor vehicle that is used to minimize the spray of water, mud, or loose material on a road be at least the width of the tire of the vehicle.

- SB 864 C D JONES ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT
Provides for powers, duties, and functions of the Southside Economic Development District.

- SB 866 SCHEDLER OCCUPATIONAL THERAPISTS

Provides for increased sources of referral for occupational therapists and for access without referral for limited services. (gov sig)

Requires real property sales validation questionnaire to be filed with parish assessor concerning transfers of real property. (2/3-CA7s2.1(A))

Provides for staggered terms of office for members of the State Board of Commerce and Industry.

- SB 901 JOHNSON ENVIRONMENTAL HEALTH
Authorizes adoption of stringent local ordinances regulating smoking.

- SB 902 BAJOIE IMMOVABLE PROPERTY
Authorizes municipalities and parishes to sell certain adjudicated vacant lots by public or private sale. (gov sig)
Read by title and finally passed as amended 35 yeas and 0 nays. Title read and adopted, bill ordered to the House. Motion to reconsider tabled.
- SB 927 ADLEY REAPPORTIONMENT
Redistricts Senate Districts 36 and 37. (gov sig)

- SB 952 B JONES TAX/TAXATION
Creates and provides for Tax Court as an administrative agency in the office of the governor. (gov sig)

Read by title, amendments adopted, ordered engrossed and recommitted to the committee on FINANCE.
- SB 953 DARDENNE LEVEES
Provides for the expansion of legal servitude on the main line levee of the Mississippi River in Ascension, East Baton Rouge, Iberville, and St. James parishes to construct walkways and bike paths.
Read by title and finally passed, 34 yeas and 0 nays. Title read and adopted and bill ordered to the House. Motion to reconsider tabled.
- SB 957 CRAVINS JUVENILES
Provides with respect to reform of juvenile justice.
Rules suspended; reported with amendments.
- SB 966 SCHEDLER CHILDREN
Provides for the membership of the Children's Cabinet and its advisory board, and extends its termination date. (gov sig)

SB 1044 CAIN TAX/INCOME/PERSONAL
 Changes the last date to pay state income tax from May 15 to September 15. (gov sig)

SB 1045 LAMBERT JUDGES

SR 19 SCHEDLER COMMENDATIONS
 Commends the Louisiana Occupational Therapy Association for its achievements and designates April 23, 2003, as "Louisiana Occupational Therapy Association Day at the Louisiana Senate".
 Introduced in the Senate. Read by title, rules suspended, adopted.

SR 20 DARDENNE COMMENDATIONS
 Recognizes Wed., April 23, 2003, as Dental Hygiene Day and commends dental hygienists for their contributions to the oral health of La. citizens.

SCR 20 MCPHERSON WILDLIFE RESOURCES
 Requests the Department of Wildlife and Fisheries to research and document the number of ducks in federal refuges in the Mississippi Flyway.
