Exempts a commercial fisherman from having to possess a "mobile food vendor's permit".  
Read by title, committee amendments read and adopted.  
Ordered engrossed and passed to a third reading.
- SB 3 DUPRE FEES/LICENSES/PERMITS  
Authorizes the purchase of an additional fresh products license, to authorize the spouse of a commercial fisherman to sell the catch while the commercial fisherman continues to fish.  
Read by title, committee amendments read and adopted.  
Ordered engrossed and passed to a third reading.
- SB 6 DUPRE ELECTION CODE  
Provides for a detailed qualification form for candidates for public office to include information relative to criminal history.  
Read by title and finally passed as amended 37 yeas and 0 nays. Title read and adopted, bill ordered to the House.  
Motion to reconsider tabled.
- SB 11 DUPRE VOTERS/VOTING  
Provides that the absentee vote of a voter who dies before the opening of the polls shall be counted.

- SB 15 DUPRE PUBLIC HEALTH  
Permits "generic" training for maintenance of individual sewer systems.  
Received from the House with amendments.
- SB 29 DUPRE COASTAL RESOURCES  
Designates the loss of coastal wetlands to be our "state crisis". (gov sig)  
Rules suspended. Called from the calendar.  
Designated a duplicate of HB 70.  
Read by title. Returned to the calendar subject to call.
- SB 39 DUPRE MOTOR VEHICLES  
Authorizes placement of America's WETLAND: Campaign to Save Coastal Louisiana stickers on public vehicles. (gov sig)  
Rules suspended; reported favorably.
- SB 49 DUPRE FEES/LICENSES/PERMITS  
Authorizes the purchase of a four-year wholesale/retail dealer's license and a four-year transport license.  
Read by title, engrossed and passed to a third reading.
- SB 122 DUPRE SHRIMP/SHRIMPING  
Authorizes the use of butterfly and bottom nets in Grand Pass.

- SB 161 BOISSIERE CIVIL SERVICE  
Constitutional amendment to remove the offices of clerk of the Municipal Court and clerk of the Traffic Court of New Orleans from the classified civil service. (2/3-CA13s1(A))  
Rules suspended, recalled from committee.  
Withdrawn from the files of the Senate.
- SB 225 THEUNISSEN SCHOOLS  
Constitutional amendment to authorize BESE to provide for the operation of failed schools, including receiving, controlling, and expending certain funds. (2/3-CA13s1(A))  
Sent to the Secretary of State on 5/2 .
- SB 231 THEUNISSEN FUNDS/FUNDING  
Provides school improvement as an optional secondary use for money in the statutory school rewards fund. (gov sig)  
Read by title, committee amendments read and adopted.  
Ordered engrossed and passed to a third reading.
- SB 242 MARIONNEAUX FISH/FISHING  
Extends the sunset provision for changing the mesh size of

commercial crawfish traps from 2003 to 2005.

Provides that local and parish roads in Vermilion Parish, without exception, shall become public if certain maintenance work is performed on them.

Provides for the establishment of the La. Center for Agricultural Science and Education. (gov sig)  
Read by title, committee amendments read and adopted.  
Ordered engrossed and passed to a third reading.
- SB 362 THEUNISSEN STUDENTS  
Requires submission to the Bd. of Regents of institutional policies that provide for permitted access of parents to the student education records of their dependent child pursuant to the federal Family Educational Rights and Privacy Act. (gov sig)  
Read by title, committee amendments read and adopted.  
Ordered engrossed and passed to a third reading.
- SB 406 CHAISSON CRIME/PUNISHMENT  
Changes certain circumstances regarding vehicular homicide, vehicular negligent injuring, and first degree vehicular injury from being elements of the crime to affirmative defenses if the circumstance is lacking. (9/30/03)  
Read by title and finally passed as amended 32 yeas and 4 nays. Title read and adopted, bill ordered to the House.  
Motion to reconsider tabled.
- SB 422 MCPHERSON PUBLIC WORKS  
Prohibits a local entity from utilizing the "design-build" concept when awarding public works contracts. (gov sig)

- SB 441 MOUNT SCHOOLS  
Prohibits conduct of student activities within 250 feet of designated gaming areas..

- SB 646 HEITMEIER PUBLIC CONTRACTS  
Provides for an exception to the Public Bid Law in the event of an extreme public emergency.

- SB 647 HEITMEIER BANKS/BANKING  
Revises provisions relative to the Louisiana Infrastructure Bank.  
Read by title, committee amendments read and adopted.  
Ordered engrossed and passed to a third reading.
- SB 673 ULLO WILDLIFE/FISHERIES DEPT  
Extends the Fisherman's Gear Compensation Fund for three more years. (07/01/03)

Provides for acceptance of bids for public works via electronic medium.

Provides for the transfer of a failed public school to a school district operated under the governance of BESE.  
Notice House conferees appointed.
- SB 720 HAINKEL FUNDS/FUNDING  
Provides for funding of a program for political subdivision and non-profit entity capital outlay projects.  
Reported favorably.
- SB 732 C ROMERO FISH/FISHING  
Reduces the minimum size mesh for commercial crawfish traps from 3/4 inch to 11/16 of an inch. (gov sig)  
Read by title, engrossed and passed to a third reading.
- SB 740 SCHEDLER SELF INSURANCE  
Provides an exception when computing security requirement for self-insured hospitals.  
Read by title, committee amendments read and adopted.  
Ordered engrossed and passed to a third reading.
- SB 752 LENTINI CRIMINAL PROCEDURE  
Authorizes the court in Jefferson Parish to alter the percentage amount of bail to be deposited when posting a bond and to charge an administrative fee.  
Read by title and finally passed, 31 yeas and 5 nays. Title read and adopted and bill ordered to the House. Motion to reconsider tabled.
- SB 759 THEUNISSEN POSTSECONDARY ED  
Creates and provides for the Process Technology Advisory Board. (gov sig)  
Read by title, committee amendments read and adopted.  
Ordered engrossed and passed to a third reading.

- SB 764 MARIONNEAUX WORKERS' COMPENSATION  
Exempts employers who fail to secure workers' compensation insurance or proper certification of self-insurance status from statutory immunity.  
Read by title, committee amendments read and adopted.  
Ordered engrossed and passed to a third reading.
- SB 767 CHAISSON CRIME/PUNISHMENT  
Creates the crime of unlawful refusal to submit to chemical tests to determine blood alcohol content after refusal to submit on two previous and separate occasions.

Requires law enforcement agencies to provide available information relative to a missing child who is believed to be a crime victim to a missing person alerting systems.

Provides relative to the mandatory minimum payment of child support.

Requires one-time fee of \$40 of any criminal defendant seeking representation by an indigent defender board.

- SB 828 BOISSIERE GAMING  
Authorizes slot machine gaming at an eligible live horse racing facility in Orleans Parish, and specifies fund dedications in St. Landry and Bossier parishes.

Reduces the monetary amount in controversy necessary to have a jury trial.
