

- SB 8 HEITMEIER FUNDS/FUNDING  
Provides for an increase in the base amount of mineral revenues that are deposited annually in the Budget Stabilization Fund. (gov sig) (2/3-CA7s10.3(A)(2)(b))  
Read by title and finally passed as amended 37 yeas and 0 nays. Title read and adopted, bill ordered to the House. Motion to reconsider tabled.
- SB 9 MOUNT TAX/TAXATION  
Extends income/franchise tax credit for the rehabilitation of historic structures located in a downtown development district. (7/1/02)  
Read by title and finally passed as amended 38 yeas and 0 nays. Title read and adopted, bill ordered to the House. Motion to reconsider tabled.
- SB 13 MOUNT TAX EXEMPTIONS  
Phases in a reduction of the state sales and use tax for certain fuels or gases purchased for residential use by the consumer. (7/1/04)  
Read by title and finally passed, 38 yeas and 0 nays. Title read and adopted and bill ordered to the House. Motion to reconsider tabled.
- SB 14 MOUNT ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT  
Extends the Quality Jobs Program.  
Read by title and finally passed as amended 38 yeas and 0 nays. Title read and adopted, bill ordered to the House. Motion to reconsider tabled.
- SB 15 MOUNT TAX/SALES  
Extends duration of tax-free shopping district. (gov sig)  
Read by title and finally passed as amended 38 yeas and 0 nays. Title read and adopted, bill ordered to the House. Motion to reconsider tabled.
- SB 22 CAIN TAX/TAXATION  
To provide that certain sales and use taxes become effective if and only if a 10 year phase-in of an individual income tax credit for residents is implemented for excess federal itemized deductions to pre-Stelly amounts to begin in 2005FY. (gov sig)  
Rules suspended; introduced in the Senate. Rules suspended, read first and second time by title and referred to the Committee on REV & FISCAL AFFAIRS.
- SR 4 HINES SENATE  
Creates the Senate Select Committee on Coastal Erosion and Flooding Control.  
Read by title, amended, adopted.  
By a vote of 37 yeas and 0 nays.
- SR 5 KOSTELKA CONDOLENCES  
Expresses condolences upon the death of James Thomas Breland.  
Rules suspended; introduced in the Senate. Read by title, rules suspended, adopted.
- SR 6 KOSTELKA CONDOLENCES  
Expresses condolences upon the death of Dennis D. Colvin.  
Rules suspended; introduced in the Senate. Read by title, rules suspended, adopted.
- SR 7 C FIELDS SENATE  
Requests Senate president to establish Senate personnel committee.  
Rules suspended; introduced in the Senate. Rules suspended, read first and second time by title and referred to the Committee on SENATE & GOV AFFAIRS.
- SR 8 HINES SENATE  
Amends the Rules of Order of the Senate to authorize the president of the Senate to restrict the authority of the secretary of the Senate upon adoption of a resolution censuring the secretary and placing him on probation and to censure and pl  
Rules suspended; introduced in the Senate, read first time by title.  
Read by title, amended, adopted.  
By a vote of 20 yeas and 16 nays.
- SR 9 MARIONNEAUX SENATE  
Calls for an election to elect a new secretary of the Senate.  
Rules suspended; introduced in the Senate, read first time by title.
