

- SB 5 N GAUTREAUX TAX/FRANCHISE/CORPORATE  
Provides for no corporate franchise tax if the taxable base is \$100,000 of less. (1/1/05)  
Reported favorably, rules suspended, read by title, ordered engrossed and passed to a third reading.
- SB 8 HEITMEIER FUNDS/FUNDING  
Provides for an increase in the base amount of mineral revenues that are deposited annually in the Budget Stabilization Fund. (gov sig) (2/3-CA7s10.3(A)(2)(b))  
Received from the House with amendments.
- SB 9 MOUNT TAX/TAXATION  
Extends income/franchise tax credit for the rehabilitation of historic structures located in a downtown development district. (7/1/02)  
Received from the House with amendments.
- SB 14 MOUNT ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT  
Extends the Quality Jobs Program.  
Received from the House with amendments.
- SB 15 MOUNT TAX/SALES  
Extends duration of tax-free shopping district. (gov sig)  
Received from the House without amendments.
- SB 22 CAIN TAX/TAXATION  
To provide that certain sales and use taxes become effective if and only if a 10 year phase-in of an individual income tax credit for residents is implemented for excess federal itemized deductions to pre-Stelly amounts to begin in 2005FY. (gov sig)  
Called from the calendar.  
Read by title and finally passed as amended 36 yeas and 0 nays. Title read and adopted, bill ordered to the House.  
Motion to reconsider tabled.
- SB 23 NEVERS TAX EXEMPTIONS  
Phases in a state sales tax exclusion for utilities at 10% per fiscal year depending on certain Revenue Estimating Conference forecasts.  
Rules suspended; introduced in the Senate. Rules suspended, read first and second time by title and referred to the Committee on REV & FISCAL AFFAIRS.
- SR 13 MOUNT COMMENDATIONS  
Commends the St. Louis Catholic Saints Boys Soccer Team from Lake Charles, Louisiana for winning the Division III State Championship.  
Rules suspended; introduced in the Senate. Read by title, rules suspended, adopted.
- SCR 8 C FIELDS COMMENDATIONS  
Commends the Southern University women's basketball team for an outstanding season and for capturing the SWAC championship.  
Introduced in the Senate. Read by title, rules suspended, adopted by the vote of 32 yeas and 0 nays and ordered to the House.
- SCR 9 C FIELDS COMMENDATIONS  
Commends the LSU Lady Tigers for an outstanding basketball season.  
Introduced in the Senate. Read by title, rules suspended, adopted by the vote of 34 yeas and 0 nays and ordered to the House.
- HB 1 HAMMETT TAX/SALES-USE, ST-EXEMPT  
Makes inapplicable, inoperable, and of no effect certain exemptions to the tax  
Reported favorably, rules suspended, read by title and referred to the Legislative Bureau.  
Reported without Legislative Bureau amendments, read by title and passed to a third reading.
- HB 2 HAMMETT TAX/SALES & USE  
Excludes certain manufacturing, agricultural, and logging machinery and equipment from the tax  
Received in the Senate. Rules suspended read first and second time by title and referred to the committee on REV & FISCAL AFFAIRS.
- HB 3 HAMMETT TAX/CORP FRANCHISE  
Phases out the inclusion of borrowed capital within the levy of the corporation franchise tax  
Received in the Senate. Read by title.

HB 8 FAUCHEUX TAX/SALES-USE, ST-EXEMPT  
 Extends the effectiveness of the sales and use tax exemption  
 for purchases of utilities by certain steelworks and blast  
 furnaces  
 Received in the Senate. Read by title.

HB 9 HAMMETT TAX/SALES-USE, STATE  
 Provides that tangible personal property shall not include  
 other constructions permanently attached  
 Received in the Senate. Read by title.

HB 10 HAMMETT TAX CREDITS  
 Reenacts the motion picture investor tax credits  
 Received in the Senate. Rules suspended read first and  
 second time by title and referred to the committee on  
 REV & FISCAL AFFAIRS.

HB 15 M STRAIN TAX/SALES-USE, ST-EXEMPT  
 Excludes certain fuels or gases purchased for residential use by  
 the consumer  
 Received in the Senate. Read by title.

HB 23 McVEA REVENUE SHARING  
 Provides for an adjustment of distribution of FY 2003-2004  
 funds within East Baton Rouge Parish  
 Received in the Senate. Rules suspended read first and  
 second time by title and referred to the committee on  
 FINANCE.

HB 32 TOWNSEND TAX/SALES-USE, LOCAL  
 Provides for the allowable uses of the proceeds derived from  
 the levy and collection of an additional sales and use tax by  
 the city of Natchitoches  
 Received in the Senate. Rules suspended read first and  
 second time by title and referred to the committee on  
 REV & FISCAL AFFAIRS.

HB 35 MONTGOMERY TAX/SALES-USE, ST-EXEMPT  
 Extends the time period for the exemption of certain buses,  
 trucks, and trailers used in interstate commerce  
 Received in the Senate. Rules suspended read first and  
 second time by title and referred to the committee on  
 REV & FISCAL AFFAIRS.

HCR 11 ALARIO STATE OFFICIALS/APPOINTD  
 Provides for legislative approval of maximum salaries for the  
 secretaries of certain executive branch departments as required  
 by the Executive Reorganization Act  
 Rules suspended, reported with amendments. Rules suspended,  
 committee amendments read and adopted. Read by title and  
 referred to the Legislative Bureau.  
 Reported without Legislative Bureau amendments, read by  
 title and passed to a third reading.
