Provides for an increase in the base amount of mineral revenues that are deposited annually in the Budget Stabilization Fund. (gov sig) (2/3-CA7s10.3(A)(2)(b))

- SB 9 MOUNT TAX/TAXATION
Extends income/franchise tax credit for the rehabilitation of historic structures located in a downtown development district. (7/1/02)

- HB 32 TOWNSEND TAX/SALES-USE, LOCAL
Provides for the allowable uses of the proceeds derived from the levy and collection of an additional sales and use tax by the city of Natchitoches
Senate floor amendments read and adopted. Read by title and finally passed as amended, 38 yeas and 0 nays; title read and adopted and bill ordered to the House. Motion to reconsider tabled.
- HB 35 MONTGOMERY TAX/SALES-USE, ST-EXEMPT
Extends the time period for the exemption of certain buses, trucks, and trailers used in interstate commerce
Read by title and finally passed, 38 yeas and 0 nays. Title read and adopted and bill ordered to the House. Motion to reconsider tabled.
- HCR 9 BRUCE STUDENT/TUITION
Requests the postsecondary education management boards to consider implementing or enhancing tuition exemption programs for law enforcement officers and firefighters
