Restores the income tax deduction for excess federal itemized deductions. (12/31/04)

- SB 2 MCPHERSON HUNTERS/HUNTING  
Constitutional amendment to preserve the freedom to hunt, fish, and trap subject to regulation, restriction, or prohibition imposed by law. (2/3-CA13s1(A))  
Read by title and referred to the committee on NATURAL RESOURCES.
- SB 3 MCPHERSON STATE OFFICIALS  
Prohibits the expenditure of any state funds where a public official is mentioned in any media advertisement, including public service advertisement.
