- SB 27 MCPHERSON FUNDS/FUNDING
Provides that revenues generated by private entities from the operation, management, or control of public lands or facilities shall be subject to legislative review.
Rules suspended; reported favorably.
- SB 39 MCPHERSON PUBLIC CONTRACTS
Requires legislative approval of certain cooperative endeavor agreements. (1/1/05)
Rules suspended; reported favorably.
- SB 46 THEUNISSEN MOTOR VEHICLES
Authorizes the use of electric personal assistive mobility device by individuals with mobility impairments. (gov sig)
Reported with amendments.
- SB 94 LENTINI CIVIL PROCEDURE
Requires an affidavit to certify when a suit against the state will result in a deficit of state funds and authorizes such affidavit to be traversed.
Read by title, committee amendments read and adopted.
Ordered engrossed and passed to a third reading.
- SB 125 ULLO CRIMINAL RECORDS
Relative to the Louisiana Child Protection Act.
Read by title, engrossed and passed to a third reading.
- SB 130 HAINKEL SHERIFFS
Removes the requirement for payment of insurance premiums of certain retired sheriffs and deputy sheriffs in any parish with a population between 100,000 and 102,000. (gov sig)
Reported favorably.
- SB 139 SCHEDLER PROBATION/PAROLE
Requires unanimous vote of all seven members for parole of a person convicted of a crime of violence against a peace officer or for a former peace officer convicted of a crime of violence.
Read by title, committee amendments read and adopted.
Ordered engrossed and passed to a third reading.
- SB 150 C D JONES GAMING
Authorizes the governing authority of Richwood in Ouachita Parish to call a local option election to allow the operation of video draw poker devices.

Provides for payment of benefits on funeral policies. (gov sig)

- SB 171 DUPRE REVENUE DEPARTMENT

Authorizes a parish board of election supervisors to schedule two commissioners to serve for half of an election day and receive half a full day's pay and increases certain commissioners salaries. (gov sig)

Requires a biennial license for onsite treatment system providers. (gov sig)
