- HB2 Bruneau UTILITIES
Recognizes restoration and rebuilding of certain utilities as a valid public purpose (Item #64)
- Read by title, returned to the calendar.
- HB5 Walker HEALTH CARE/FACILITIES
Provides for the Department of Health and Hospitals to promulgate rules for the establishment, reestablishment, or continued operation of nursing facilities, hospitals, and intermediate care facilities for the mentally retarded located in areas subject to hurricanes, tidal surges, or flooding (Item #43)
- Read third time by title, amended, roll called on final passage, yeas 103, nays 0. Finally passed, title adopted, ordered to the Senate.
- HB6 Pinac ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT
Extends time limit for certain investment deadlines under the CAPCO program due to the impact of Hurricanes Katrina and Rita (Item #75)
- Read third time by title, roll called on final passage, yeas 102, nays 0. Finally passed, title adopted, ordered to the Senate.
- HB7 Salter LEGISLATIVE EXPENSES
Provides relative to payment of certain expenses related to the legislative offices of certain temporarily displaced legislators (Item #62)
- Read third time by title, roll called on final passage, yeas 104, nays 0. Finally passed, title adopted, ordered to the Senate.
- HB9 LaFleur ETHICS
Requires elected officials and appointed state officials to disclose information regarding certain contracts and subcontracts (Item #6)
- Read third time by title, amended, roll called on final passage, yeas 85, nays 19. Finally passed, title adopted, ordered to the Senate.
- HB11 Smiley MTR VEHICLE/REGISTRATION
Provides for disposal of water-damaged vehicles (Item #13)
- Read by title, returned to the calendar.
- Notice given.
- HB17 Hutter RETIREMENT/CONTRIBUTIONS
Waives interest due on certain delinquent retirement contributions for a specified time period (Item #73)
- Read third time by title, amended, roll called on final passage, yeas 103, nays 0. Finally passed, title adopted, ordered to the Senate.
- HB18 Hutter RETIREMENT BENEFITS
Provides for public employees on involuntary furlough or leave without pay due to a disaster to continue to earn service credit in their retirement systems by making employee and employer contributions (Item #65)
- Read by title, returned to the calendar.
- Notice given.
- HB29 Martiny CRIMINAL/BAIL
Provides that certain criminal bail bonds are void because of destruction of records and property by Hurricanes Katrina and Rita (Item #66)
- Discharged from the Committee on Administration of Criminal Justice.
- Read by title, withdrawn from the files of the House.

HB42	Montgomery	TAX/SALES-USE-EXEMPT	Provides that the state sales or use tax shall not apply to consumer purchases from certain dealers of tangible personal property for non-business use on a certain date (Item #7) <ul style="list-style-type: none">- Read by title, amended, returned to the calendar.- Notice given.
HB45	Hammett	TAX	Provides for the furnishing of tax information to the taxpayer or his duly authorized representative (Item #49) <ul style="list-style-type: none">- Read third time by title, roll called on final passage, yeas 104, nays 0. Finally passed, title adopted, ordered to the Senate.
HB51	Bruneau	ETHICS	Provides relative to the receipt of any thing of economic value by an elected or appointed official or certain related persons as a result of federally funded contracts or subcontracts arising as a result of a gubernatorially declared disaster or emergency (Item #6) <ul style="list-style-type: none">- Read by title, returned to the calendar.
HB59	Jefferson	ELECTIONS	Provides relative to the conduct of elections during or following a gubernatorially declared state of emergency (Items #57 and 58) <ul style="list-style-type: none">- Read by title, returned to the calendar.- Notice given.
HB63	Schneider	RETIREMENT/DROP	Allows certain Hurricane Katrina victims to take in-service distributions from their DROP accounts (Item #59) <ul style="list-style-type: none">- Read third time by title, roll called on final passage, yeas 103, nays 0. Finally passed, title adopted, ordered to the Senate.
HB75	Jefferson	BANKS/BANKING	Authorizes banks to make investmests to promote public welfare in low-income communities affected by Hurricanes Katrina and Rita <ul style="list-style-type: none">- Read by title, returned to the calendar.
HB120	Schneider	RETIREMENT/DROP	Allows certain Hurricane Rita victims to take in-service distributions from their DROP accounts (Item #59) <ul style="list-style-type: none">- Read third time by title, roll called on final passage, yeas 102, nays 0. Finally passed, title adopted, ordered to the Senate.
HB131	Salter	FEES/LICENSES/PERMITS	Provides relative to the effective date of the Healthcare Affordability Act (Item #18) <ul style="list-style-type: none">- Read third time by title, roll called on final passage, yeas 101, nays 0. Finally passed, title adopted, ordered to the Senate.
HB135	Pinac	FINANCIAL INSTNS COMMR	

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Provides relative to the emergency powers of the commissioner of the Office of Financial Institutions relative to nondepository institutions

- HB142 Salter STUDENT/LOANS-SCHOLARSHP
Provides relative to TOPS continuing eligibility requirements for the 2005-06 academic year for postsecondary students displaced during such academic year as a consequence of Hurricane Katrina or Rita, or both (Item #37)
 - Read third time by title, roll called on final passage, yeas 89, nays 5. Finally passed, title adopted, ordered to the Senate.
- HB143 Salter STUDENT/LOANS-SCHOLARSHP
Provides relative to initial eligibility requirements for TOPS awards for high school students displaced during the 2005-2006 school year as a consequence of Hurricane Katrina or Rita, or both (Item #37)
 - Read third time by title, roll called on final passage, yeas 93, nays 1. Finally passed, title adopted, ordered to the Senate.
- HB156 Alario APPROPRIATIONS/SUPPLEML
Supplemental appropriations and reductions in appropriations for Fiscal Year 2005-2006 (Item #30)
 - Read by title, rules suspended, referred to the Committee on Appropriations.
- HB157 Alario BONDS/GENERAL OBLIGATION
Authorizes issuance of bonds and provides for use of bond proceeds to provide relief from natural catastrophe (Item #28)
 - Read by title, rules suspended, referred to the Committee on Appropriations.
- HB158 Alario BONDS/STATE
Excludes from net state tax supported debt certain bonds or notes issued by the state to provide relief from the natural catastrophe caused by Hurricanes Katrina and Rita (Item #29)
 - Read by title, rules suspended, referred to the Committee on Ways and Means.
- HB159 Hebert TAX/SALES-USE, STATE
Authorizes refunds for sales taxes paid on certain automobiles destroyed by a natural disaster
 - Read by title, rules suspended, referred to the Committee on Ways and Means.
- HB160 Montgomery TECHNOLOGY
Provides with respect to the Louisiana Geographic Information System (Item #26)
 - Read by title, rules suspended, referred to the Committee on House and Governmental Affairs.
- HB161 Carter, K. ATTORNEY GENERAL
Authorizes the attorney general to issue cease and desist orders to prohibit charter schools under certain circumstances
 - Read by title, rules suspended, referred to the Committee on Judiciary.
- HCR2 Lancaster VOTING/REGISTRATION
Suspends the provisions of law relative to the annual canvass of voters until 60 days after the 2006 Regular Session (Item #56)
 - Read by title, roll called on final consideration, yeas 103, nays 0. The resolution was adopted and ordered to the Senate.
- HCR4 Hutter INSURANCE
Memorializes congress to create the National Wind Insurance Program

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- Read by title, returned to the calendar.
- Called from the calendar.
- Read by title, amended, adopted, ordered to the Senate.

- HCR12 Bruneau COMMERCIAL REGULATIONS
Urges and requests the state Office of Financial Institutions, the Federal Deposit Insurance Corporation, and the federal Office of the Comptroller of the Currency to provide flexibility for the modification of loan terms for entities and persons affected by Hurricane Katrina or Rita
- Read by title, adopted, ordered to the Senate.
- HCR13 Jefferson CURRICULA
Requests BESE to develop and implement an age, grade, and geographically appropriate curriculum for disaster awareness education in all city, parish, and other local public school systems
- Read by title, adopted, ordered to the Senate.
- HCR15 Schneider RETIREMENT/DROP
Memorializes congress to grant for distributions from DROP accounts to active government employees who are members of public retirement systems similar tax relief to that provided by the Katrina Emergency Tax Relief Act of 2005
- Read by title, adopted, ordered to the Senate.
- HCR23 Carter, K. INSURANCE/FLOOD
Memorializes the United States Congress to increase the coverage limit for a single-family structure under the National Flood Insurance Program from \$250,000 to \$500,000
- Read by title, adopted, ordered to the Senate.
- HCR24 Carter, K. INSURANCE/FLOOD
Urges and requests the Louisiana Property and Casualty Insurance Commission to study and to work to bring more insurers who write supplemental flood insurance coverage into Louisiana
- Read by title, adopted, ordered to the Senate.
- HCR25 Dorsey PUBLIC SFTY/CORRECT DEPT
Provides with respect to emergency plans for displaced sex offenders
- Read by title, adopted, ordered to the Senate.
- HCR26 Pinac RACING/HORSE
Suspends the provision of law requiring minimum number of live racing days
- Read by title, roll called on final consideration, yeas 86, nays 10. The resolution was adopted and ordered to the Senate.
- HCR27 Schneider RETIREMENT/DROP
Memorializes congress to grant similar tax relief for Hurricane Rita victims as that provided by the Katrina Emergency Tax Relief Act of 2005 and to include DROP account distributions to active employees who are members of public retirement systems and victims of Katrina or Rita as eligible plan distributions
- Read by title, adopted, ordered to the Senate.
- HCR31 Gray ELECTIONS
Requests the Louisiana secretary of state to work cooperatively with other agencies to contact all displaced individuals to provide them information relative to their voting rights and how to register to vote and vote in upcoming elections
- Read by title, adopted, ordered to the Senate.
- HCR33 LaFonta INSURANCE/FLOOD

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Urges and requests the Federal Emergency Management Agency to finalize updated floodplain maps for the city of New Orleans

- Received from the Senate without amendments.
- Enrolled and signed by the Speaker of the House.

HCR35 Faucheux TAX CREDITS
Urges and requests the motion picture industry to locate more productions in Louisiana to help speed economic recovery

- Enrolled and signed by the Speaker of the House.

HCR36 Jefferson CONGRESS
Memorializes congress to waive the local share presently required for funding of levee improvements

- Read by title, referred to the Committee on Transportation, Highways, and Public Works.

HCR37 Walsworth SCHOOLS/FINANCE-MFP
Approves adjustments adopted by BESE on 11/9/2005 to the MFP formula for FY 2005-06 approved by the legislature as SCR 125 of the 2005 R.S.

- Read by title, rules suspended, referred to the Committee on Education.

HCR38 Scalise EMPLOYMENT
Memorializes congress to require all federal jobs that have been lost or relocated due to Hurricanes Katrina and Rita and their associated funding to be restored as soon as possible

- Read by title, rules suspended, adopted, ordered to the Senate.

HCR39 Scalise WEAPONS/FIREARMS
Requests the governor to include in the call of this session legislation to protect inherent rights of citizens

- Read by title. Lies over under the rules.

HR8 Gallot CONDOLENCES
Expresses condolences upon the death of Lula Leonard Dunn

- Enrolled, signed by the Speaker of the House and taken by the Clerk of the House to the Secretary of State in accordance with the Rules of the House.

HR9 Hebert HOUSE/RULES
Provides the voting machine does not indicate a member's vote to any person until the machine is closed

- Read by title, rules suspended, referred to the Committee on House and Governmental Affairs.

SB1 Amedee SEX OFFENSES
Provides for registration of sex offenders in emergency housing, enhances penalties for failure to register, and requires re-registration under certain circumstances.

- Read by title, returned to the calendar.

SB8 Murray PUBLIC UTILITIES
Recognizes restoration and rebuilding of certain utilities as a valid public purpose. (gov sig)

- Read by title and designated duplicate of HB 2.
- Referred to the Legislative Bureau.

SB10 Nevers UNEMPLOYMENT COMP
Provides for unemployment compensation benefits. (gov sig)

- Reported with amendments (10-0) (Regular). Referred to the Legislative Bureau.

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SB16	Schedler	INSURERS	Requires that settlement monies on claims arising under homeowners insurance policies be placed in interest-earning escrow accounts with the interest accruing to the claimant under such policy. (gov sig) - Read by title, under the rules, referred to the Committee on Insurance.
SB48	Murray	INSURANCE POLICIES	Requires certain insurers to itemize coverages included in payments made to the insured. (gov sig) - Received in the House from the Senate, rules suspended, read by title, lies over under the rules
SB55	Adley	INSURERS	Requires insurers to itemize coverages included in payments to the insured. (gov sig) - Read by title, under the rules, referred to the Committee on Insurance.
SB66	Chaisson	CRIMINAL PROCEDURE	Provide for the operation of the criminal justice system during an emergency or disaster. (gov sig) - Received in the House from the Senate, rules suspended, read by title, lies over under the rules
SCR5	Jones	PARISHES	Urges the governor to include East Carroll Parish as a community in the Northern Louisiana Renewal Community. - Read by title, rules suspended, concurred in.
SCR11	Smith, Mike	COMMUNITY TECH SYSTEM	Requests that the governor expedite appointments to the Board of Supervisors of Community and Technical Colleges. - Discharged from the Committee on Education. - Read by title, rules suspended, concurred in.
SCR12	Heitmeier	FUNDS/FUNDING	Authorizes incorporation of certain monies from the Budget Stabilization Fund into the official forecast for FY 2005-2006. (2/3 - CA7s10.3(C)(2)) - Received in the House from the Senate. - Read by title, rules suspended, referred to the Committee on Appropriations.
