HB162	Hunter	APPROPRIATIONS/SUPPLEML	Provides for supplemental appropriations and reductions to appropriations for FY 2005-2006 from the State General Fund and other funds (Item #30) - Read by title, rules suspended, referred to the Committee on Appropriations.
HCR17	Alario	FUNDS/FUNDING-BUDGET, ST	Authorizes incorporation of certain monies from the Budget Stabilization Fund into the official forecast for FY 2005-2006 (Item #30) - Reported favorably (14-0). - Rules suspended. - Read by title, returned to the calendar.
HCR39	Scalise	WEAPONS/FIREARMS	Requests the governor to include in the call of this session legislation to protect inherent rights of citizens - Read by title, referred to the Committee on Administration of Criminal Justice.
HCR40	LaFonta	ENVIRONMENT	Requests the Environmental Protection Agency to conduct a comprehensive study of the environment in the parishes affected by Hurricane Katrina. - Read by title, rules suspended, adopted, ordered to the Senate.
SB8	Murray	PUBLIC UTILITIES	Recognizes restoration and rebuilding of certain utilities as a valid public purpose. (gov sig) - Reported without Legislative Bureau amendments. - Rules suspended. Read by title, passed to 3rd reading - regular calendar.
SB10	Nevers	UNEMPLOYMENT COMP	Provides for unemployment compensation benefits. (gov sig) - Reported without Legislative Bureau amendments. - Rules suspended. Read by title, amended, passed to 3rd reading - regular calendar.
SB48	Murray	INSURANCE POLICIES	Requires certain insurers to itemize coverages included in payments made to the insured. (gov sig) - Read by title, under the rules, referred to the Committee on Insurance.
SB66	Chaisson	CRIMINAL PROCEDURE	Provide for the operation of the criminal justice system during an emergency or disaster. (gov sig) - Read by title, returned to the calendar.
SCR12	Heitmeier	FUNDS/FUNDING	Authorizes incorporation of certain monies from the Budget Stabilization Fund into the official forecast for FY 2005-2006. (2/3 - CA7s10.3(C)(2)) - Reported favorably (14-0). - Rules suspended. Read by title, passed to 3rd reading.
